Subject : Water for Gargaselle beams - Budget I 2

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In a preliminary study made by L. Danley, which takes into account the likely development of the East and South East Area (Gargaselle) beams, it can be shown that the new water supply (15 MW with  $\Delta T = 30$  and input water at  $30^{\circ}\text{C}$ ) will be inadequate for the maximum programme by some 2-3 MW. Whilst no decision has been made on this point I think it would be a good idea to include a sum of money in the budget estimation now being made. The date for operating any extension of the system would be about 1971. As there is likely to be a long shut-down in 1972 money should be included in that year's budget.
