In a preliminary study made by L. Danloy, which takes into account the likely development of the East and South East Area (Gargamolle) beams, it can be shown that the new mater supply (15 NW with  $\Delta T = 30$  and input water at 30°C) will be inadequate for the <u>maximum</u> programs by some 2-3 NW. Whilst no decision has been made on this point I think it would be a good idea to include a sum of money in the budget estimation now being made. The date for concrating any extension of the system would be ebout 1973. As there is likely to be a long shut-down in 1972 worsy should be included in that year's budget.
