



Distribution of Illicit Drug Toxicity Deaths (2015 – 2024)

The maps provide geographical representation of the illicit drug toxicity deaths in British Columbia. The BC Coroners Service data includes all illicit drug toxicity deaths in British Columbia (accidental and undetermined) that occurred between January 1, 2015 and April 30, 2024, inclusive. The BC Centre for Disease Control geocoded the data using information that best represents the location of the toxicity event.


The population denominators for the Local Health Area (LHA) maps are from the BC Stats Population Estimates and PEOPLE data files; rates are calculated based on the corresponding year. For regions with small population size, the rates based on a small number of annual deaths may yield unstable rates (i.e. rates may fluctuate widely from year to year). Furthermore, data are suppressed in regions where the annual number of all-cause deaths is fewer than 20, or where the First Nations population is greater than 50%.

Please note that the BC Coroners Service operates in a live database environment. Some data for more recent years are based on preliminary circumstances and are subject to change as investigations are concluded. Data are not directly comparable to published counts from previous years.
