 Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute.

Final Outcome

- In a two-game, combined-point match, broadcast in three Jeopardy! episodes February 14–16, Watson beat Brad Rutter, the biggest all-time money winner on Jeopardy! (>\$3.4 million), and Ken Jennings, the record holder for the longest championship streak (74 wins).
- Watson received the first prize of \$1 million, while Ken Jennings and Brad Rutter received \$300,000 and \$200,000, respectively. Jennings and Rutter pledged to donate half their winnings to charity, while IBM divided Watson's winnings between two charities.
