



NSF Statistics: U.S. Researchers by Position Over Time








#### NIH NRSA Postdoctoral Fellows and Trainees, and Stipend Level


Decreasing awards and increasing stipends (but low compared to industry)

Stipend Level, 2010 - 2022








#### **Doctorate Recipient Employment Commitments**


