Of the many Novelties brought to notice every year, there are but few, indeed, that possess any intrinsic value. We offer only those that we find, after careful tests, are worthy of introduction.

Parcel Post.—Seeds and bulbs can now be sent by parcel post in the same manner as general merchandise. We deliver free, at the prices herein quoted, seeds in packets, ounces, and up to one-fourth pound, of any variety. In quantities of 8 ounces and upward, postage must be added to the list price. On all the articles in this list that can be sent by parcel post, the mailing weight is given.

See the following schedule of parcel-post rates for all zones.

PARCEL-POST RATES

Parcels of seeds and bulbs weighing 8 ounces or less must pay postage to all zones at the rate of one cent for each 2 ounces; in excess of 8 ounces, at pound rates. Parcels of general merchandise weighing 4 ounces or less, must pay postage to all zones at the rate of one cent per ounce; in excess of 4 ounces, at pound rates.

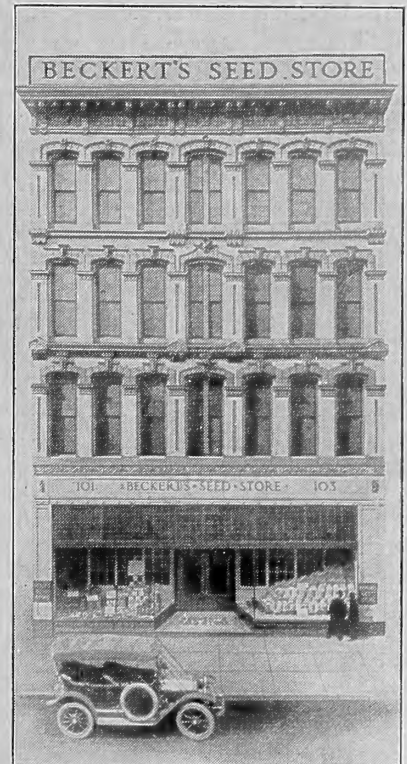
