167Yb DECAY

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The level scheme of the deformed nucleus ¹⁶⁷Tm has been investigated in the decay of ¹⁶⁷Yb using germanium detectors and a magnetic beta spectrograph. The conversion electron spectrum, single gamma-ray spectra and prompt and delayed gamma-gamma-coincidences have been measured. About 45 new transition have been observed. Most of them have been introduced into a level scheme of ¹⁶⁷Tm containing 13 new levels. In the low-energy region besides the rotational bands 1/2⁺ [411], 7/2⁺ [404] and 7/2⁻ [523] the 5/2 and 9/2 members of the 1/2⁻ [541] band could be identified. The possibilities of interpretation of the high-lying levels are discussed basing on the microscopic model.

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
