

**JOINT COMMUNIQUE
ON ESTABLISHMENT OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS
BETWEEN
GEORGIA
AND
THE REPUBLIC OF CAMEROON**

The Government of Georgia and the Government of the Republic of Cameroon, Desirous:

1. to sustain and to strengthen the friendly relations between their two countries in the mutual interest of their peoples;
2. to promote and intensify cooperation between their respective countries, in the political, economic and cultural domain;


On the basis of their common adherence to the principles of the international law, the goals and objectives of the United Nations Organization as regards to the need to preserve international peace and security, and eliminate all forms of discrimination;

Parties have agreed to base their diplomatic relations on the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of 18 April, 1961 and the Vienna Convention on Consular Relations of 24 April, 1963;

Decide to establish diplomatic relations between the two countries at Ambassadorial level from today.



Désireux :

1. d'entretenir et de consolider les relations d'amitié existant entre leurs deux pays dans l'intérêt mutuel de leurs Peuples ;
2. de promouvoir et d'intensifier la coopération entre leurs deux pays respectifs, dans les domaines Politique, Economique, Social et Culturel ;

Se fondant sur leur commun attachement aux Principes du droit international, aux Buts et Objectifs de l'Organisation des Nations Unies en ce qui concerne la nécessité de préserver la Paix et la Sécurité Internationale, et d'éliminer toutes les formes de Discrimination ;

Agissant sur la base de la Convention de Vienne du 18 avril 1961 sur les relations diplomatiques et de la Convention de Vienne du 24 avril 1963 sur les relations consulaires;

Décident d'établir des relations diplomatiques entre leurs deux Pays respectifs au niveau des Ambassadeurs pour compter de ce jour.

Fait à New York, le 26 Septembre 2013 en langues géorgienne, anglaise et française.


