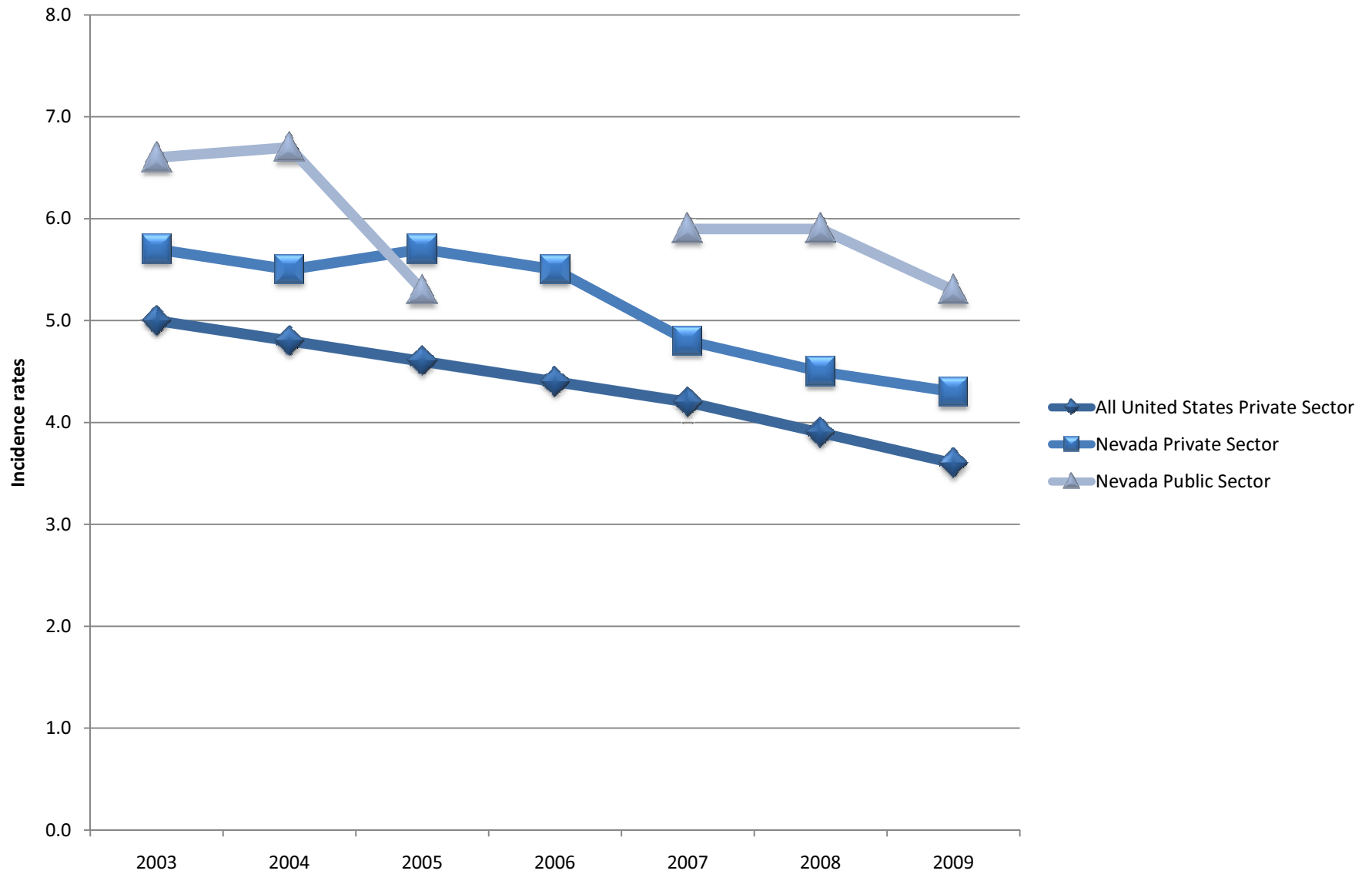
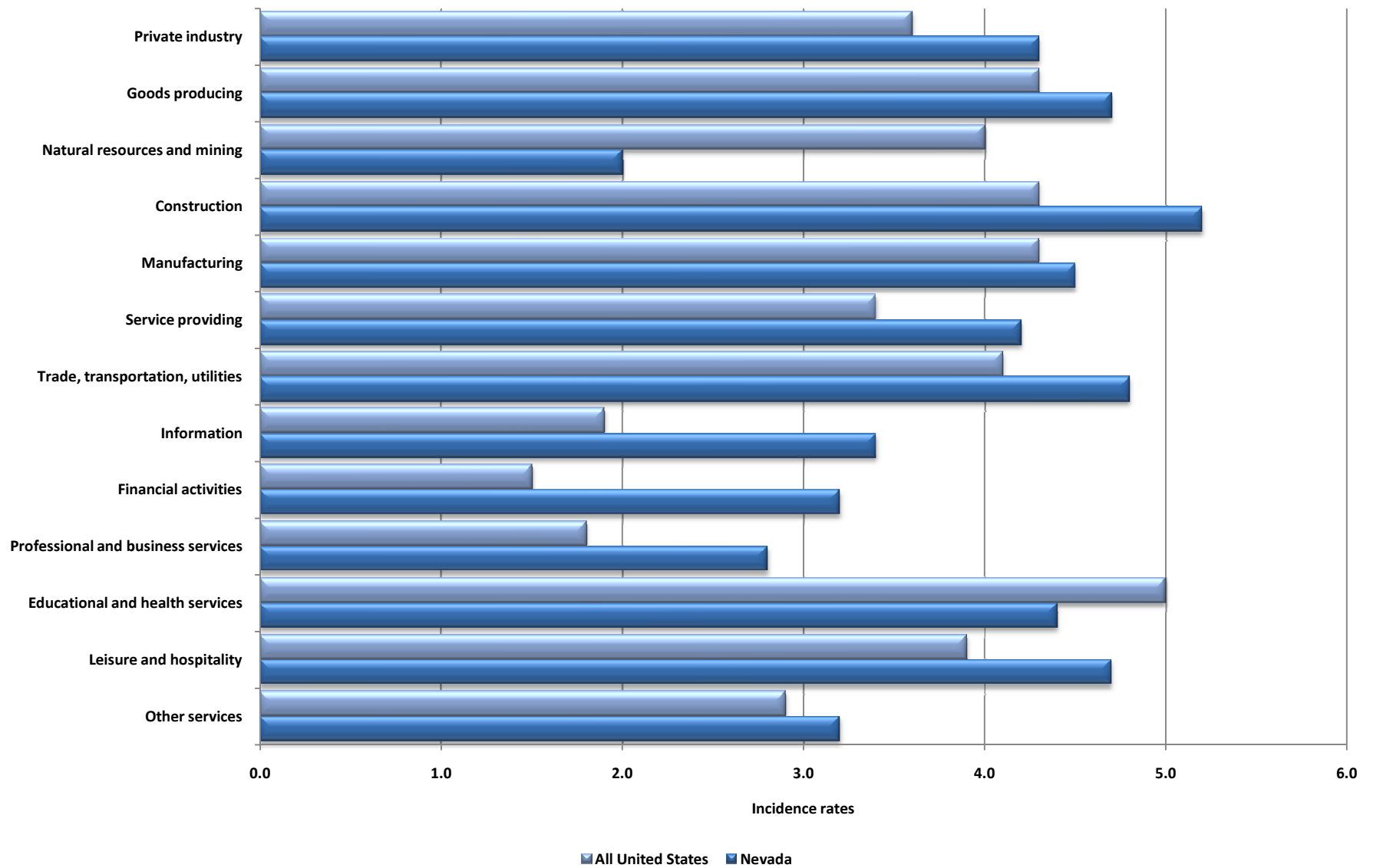


Chart 1. Incidence rates per 100 full-time workers for total nonfatal occupational injuries and illnesses, Nevada and All United States, 2003-2009



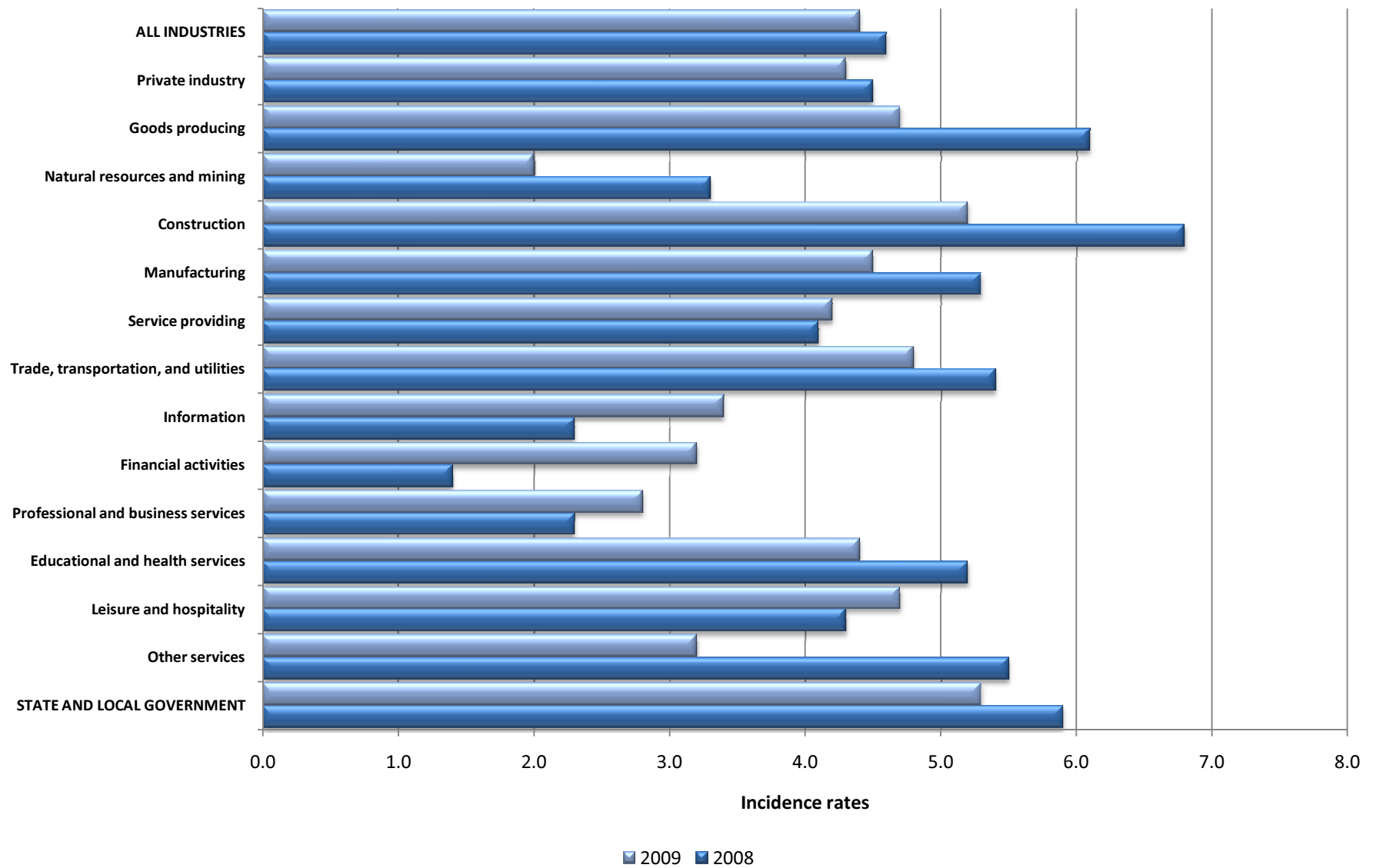

Chart 2. Incidence rates per 100 full-time workers for total nonfatal occupational injuries and illnesses by major industry sector, Nevada and All United States, 2009



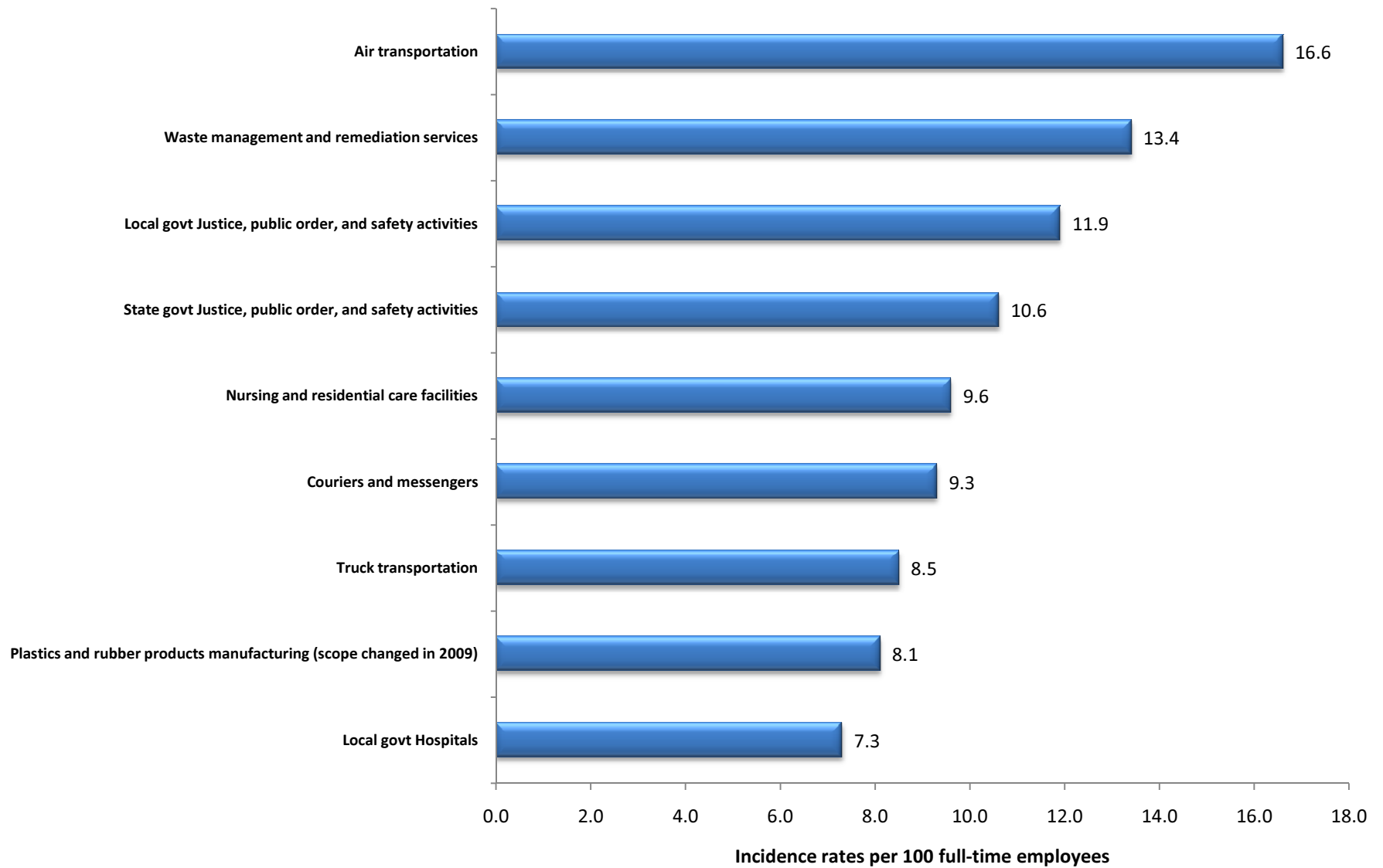

Chart 3. Incidence rates per 100 full-time workers for total nonfatal occupational injuries and illnesses by major industry sector, Nevada, 2008 & 2009



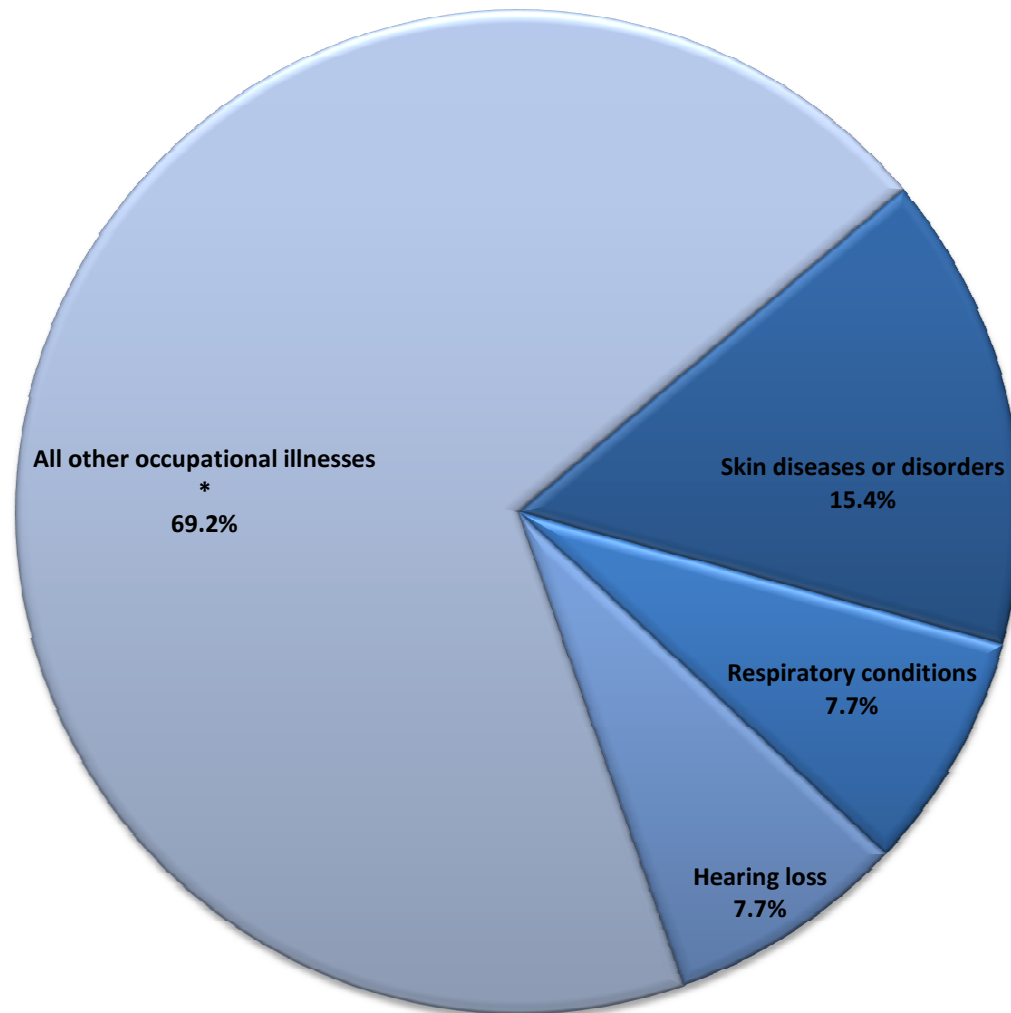

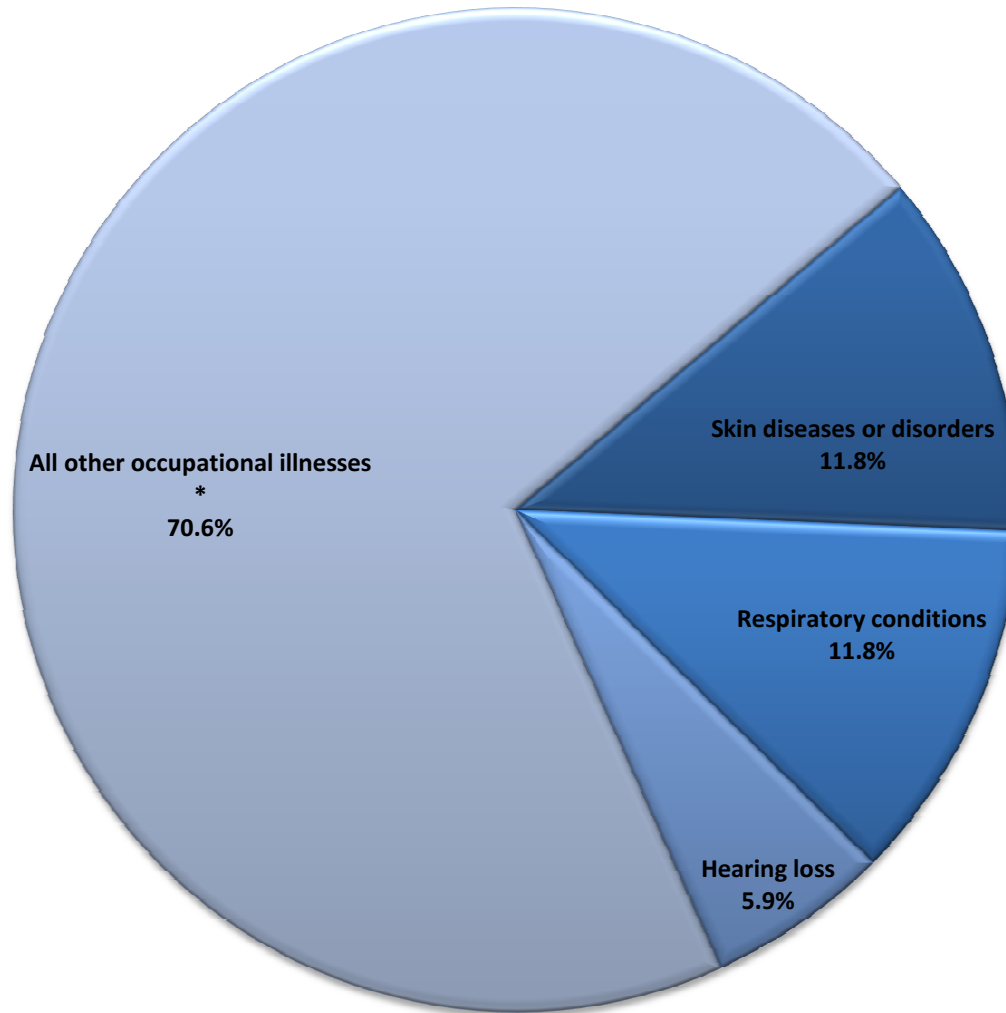
**Chart 5A. Distribution of illnesses by category of illness,

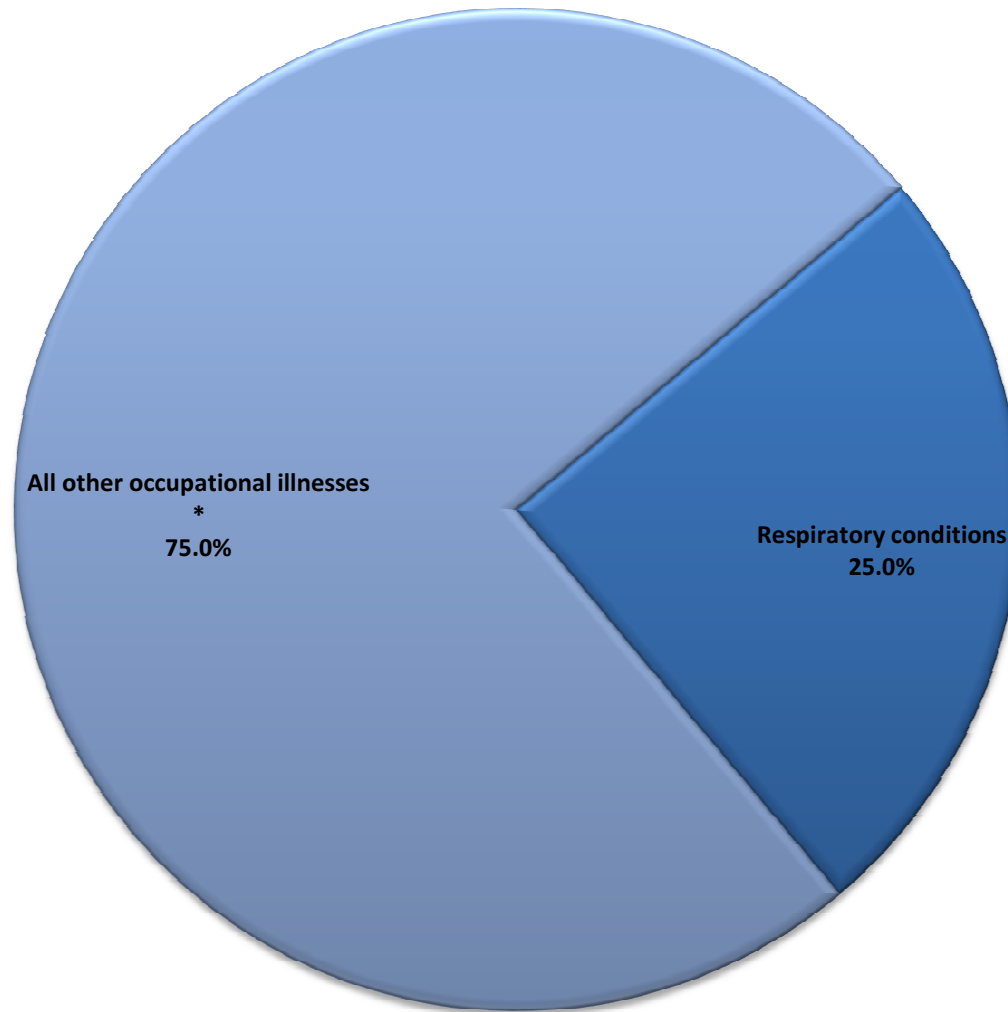
**Chart 5B. Distribution of illnesses by category of illness,

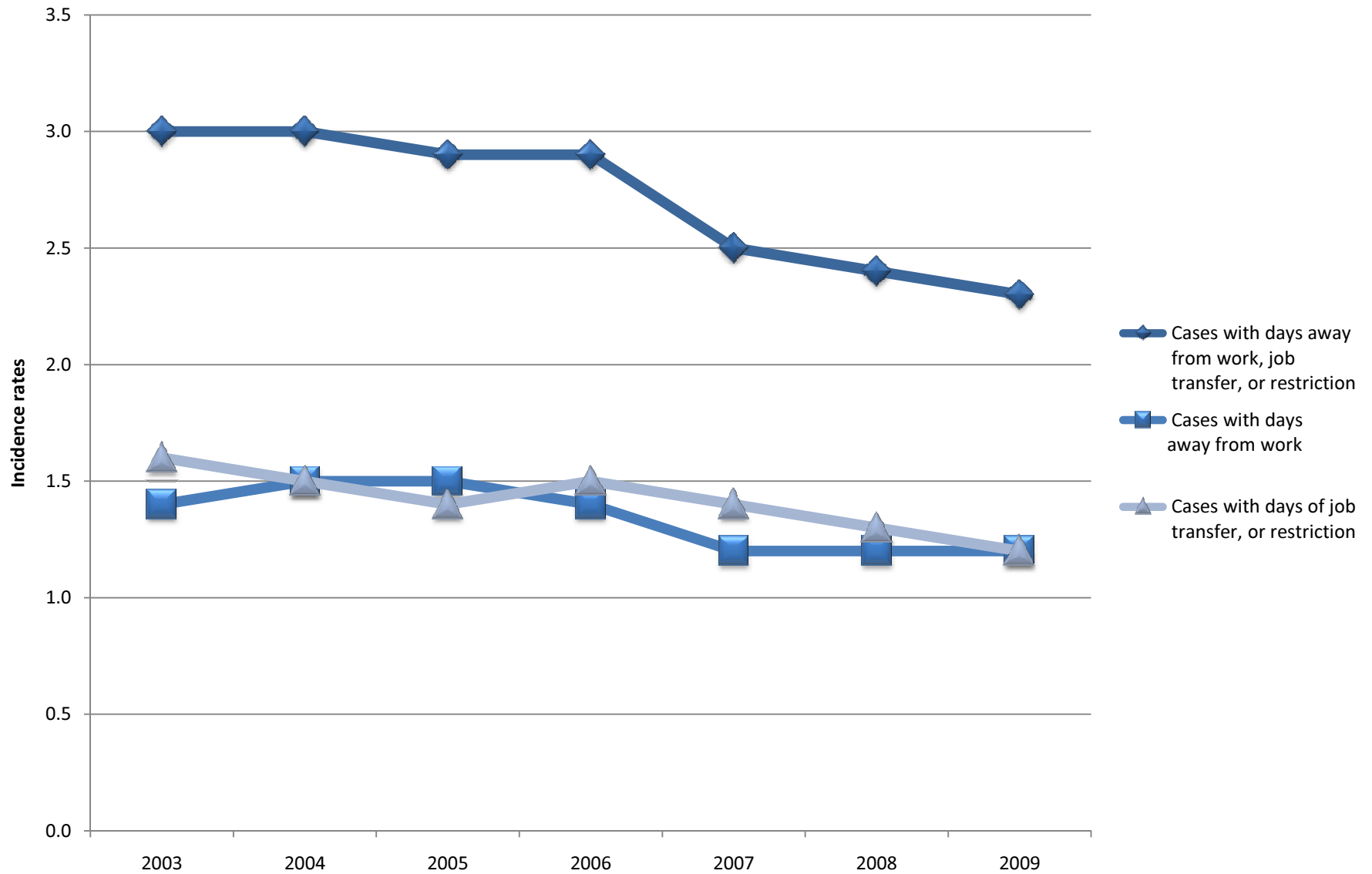
**Chart 5C. Distribution of illnesses by category of illness,

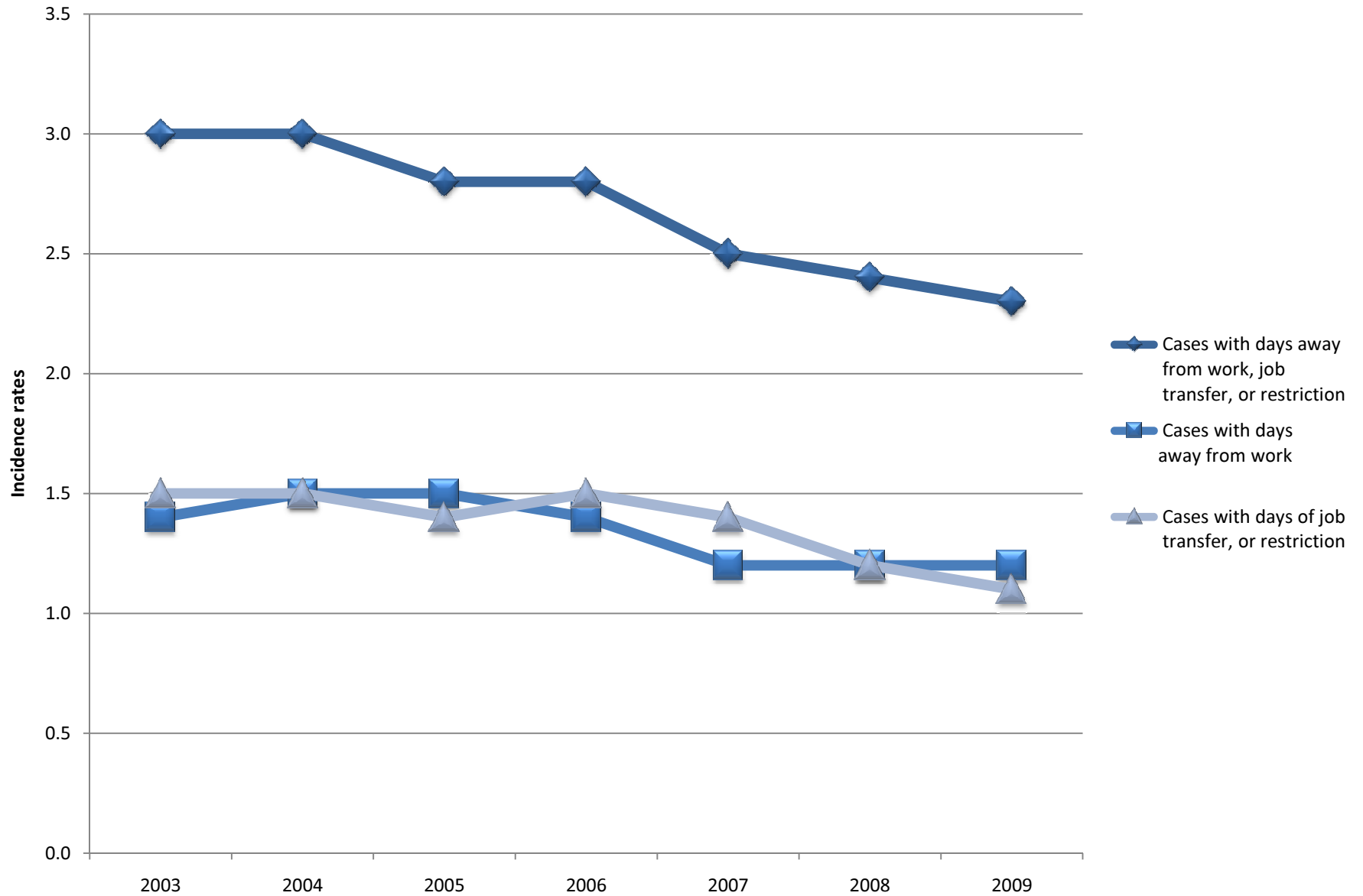

Nevada, private industry, 2003-2009**



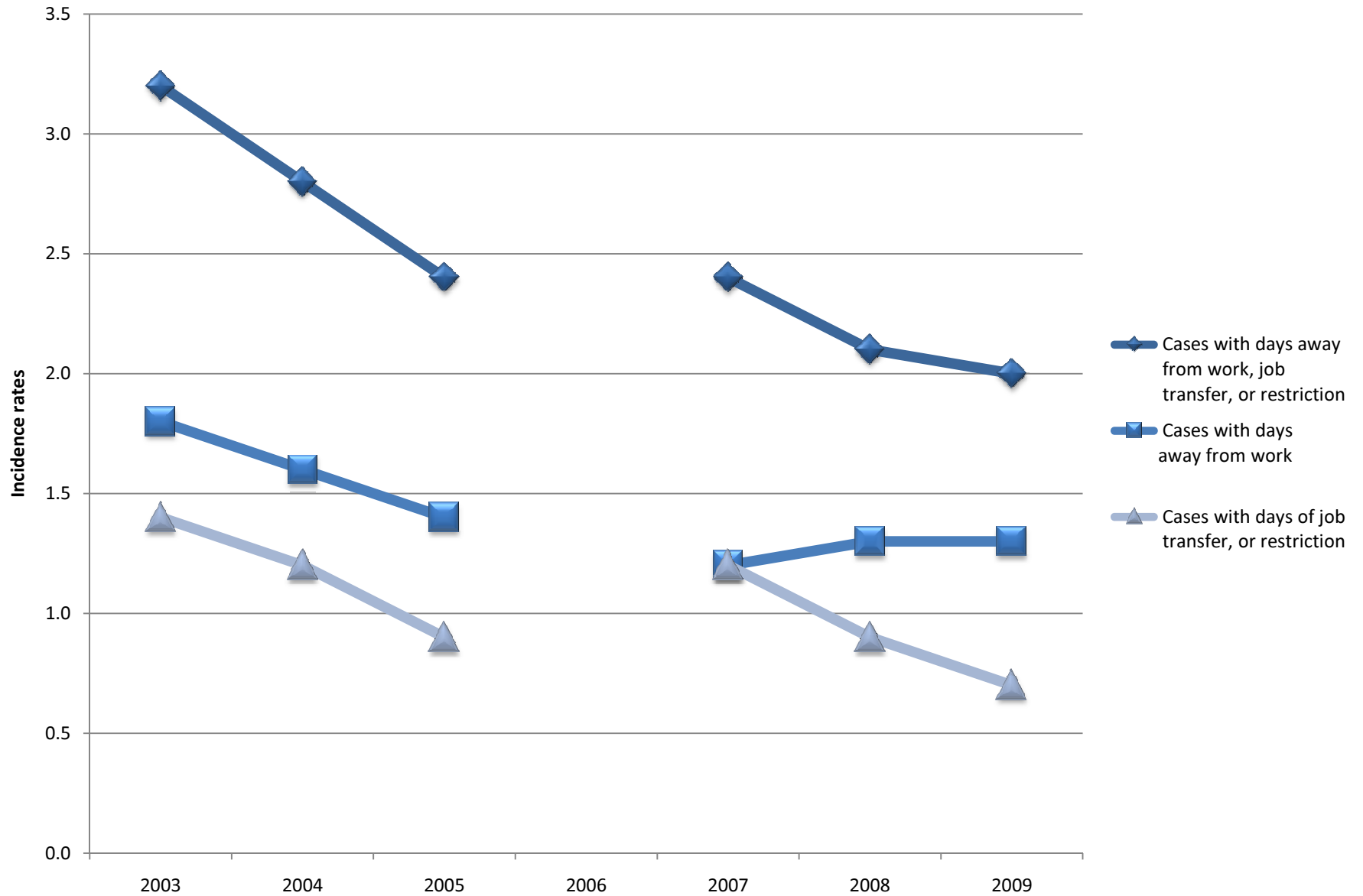

Chart 6B. Cases with days away from work, job transfer, or restriction incidence rates, injuries and illnesses, Nevada, all ownerships, 2003-2009



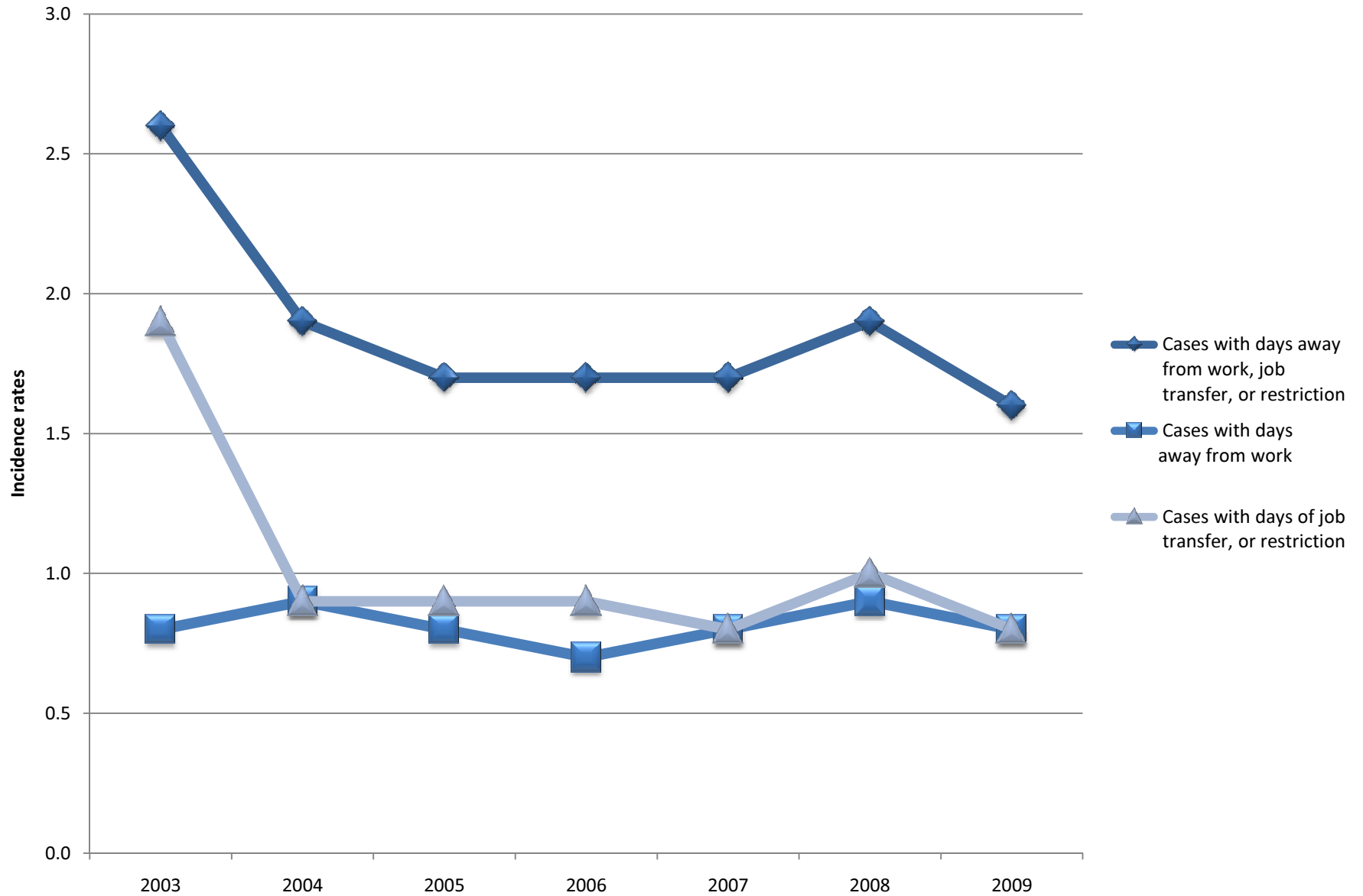

Chart 6C. Cases with days away from work, job transfer, or restriction incidence rates, injuries and illnesses, Nevada, state and local governments, 2003-2009



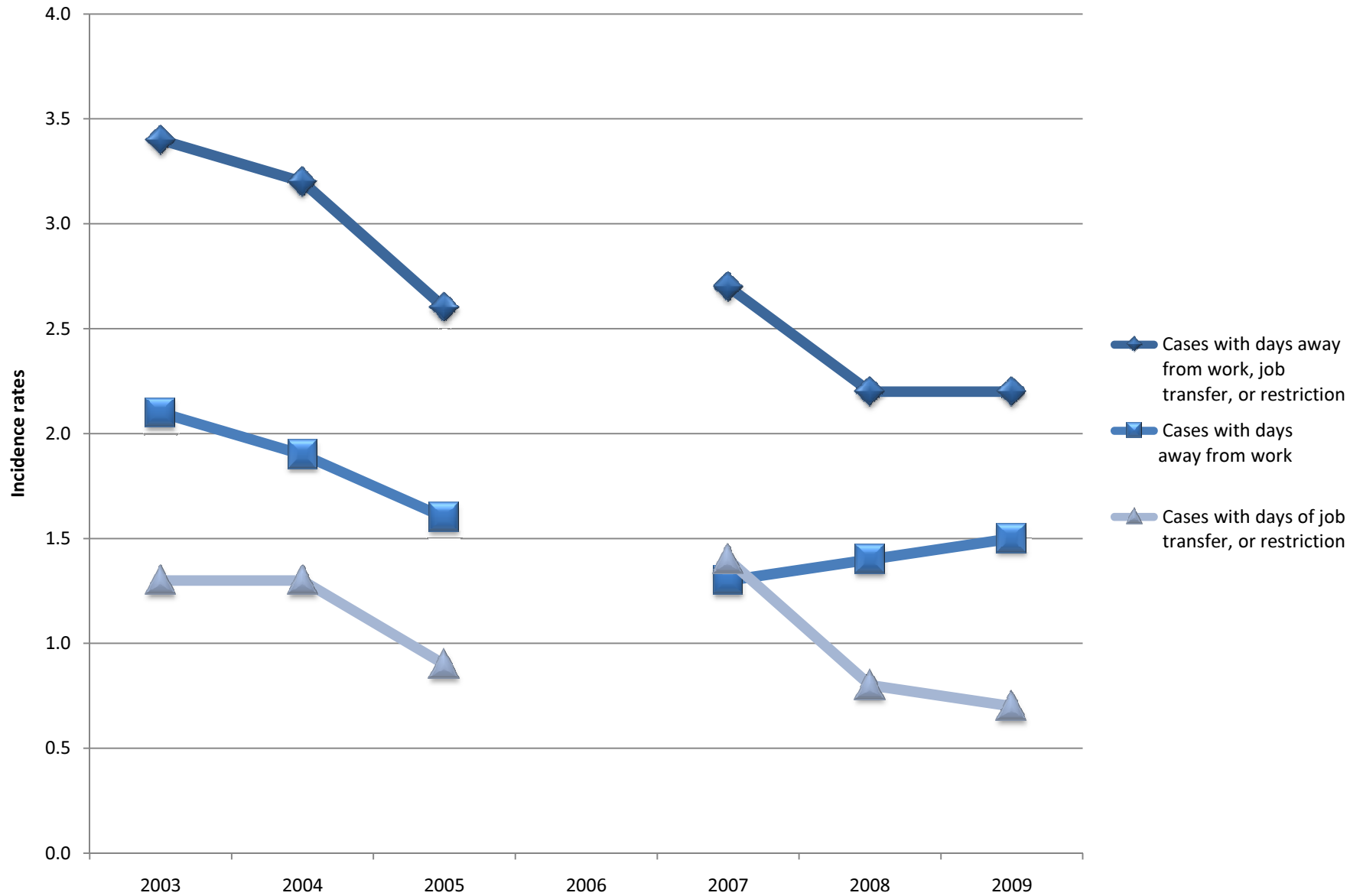

Chart 6D. Cases with days away from work, job transfer, or restriction incidence rates, injuries and illnesses, Nevada, state government, 2003-2009



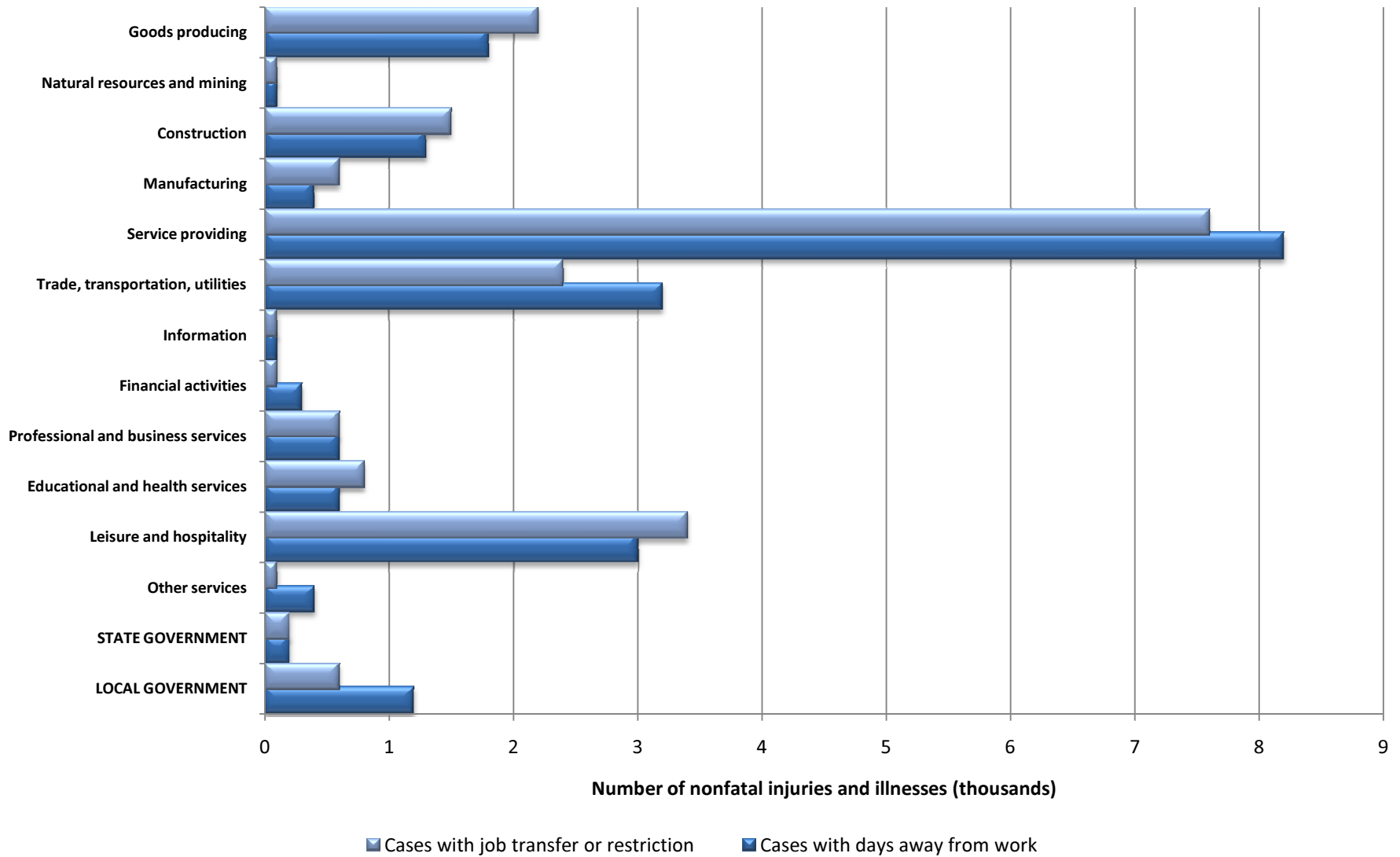

Chart 6E. Cases with days away from work, job transfer, or restriction incidence rates, injuries and illnesses, Nevada, local government, 2003-2009



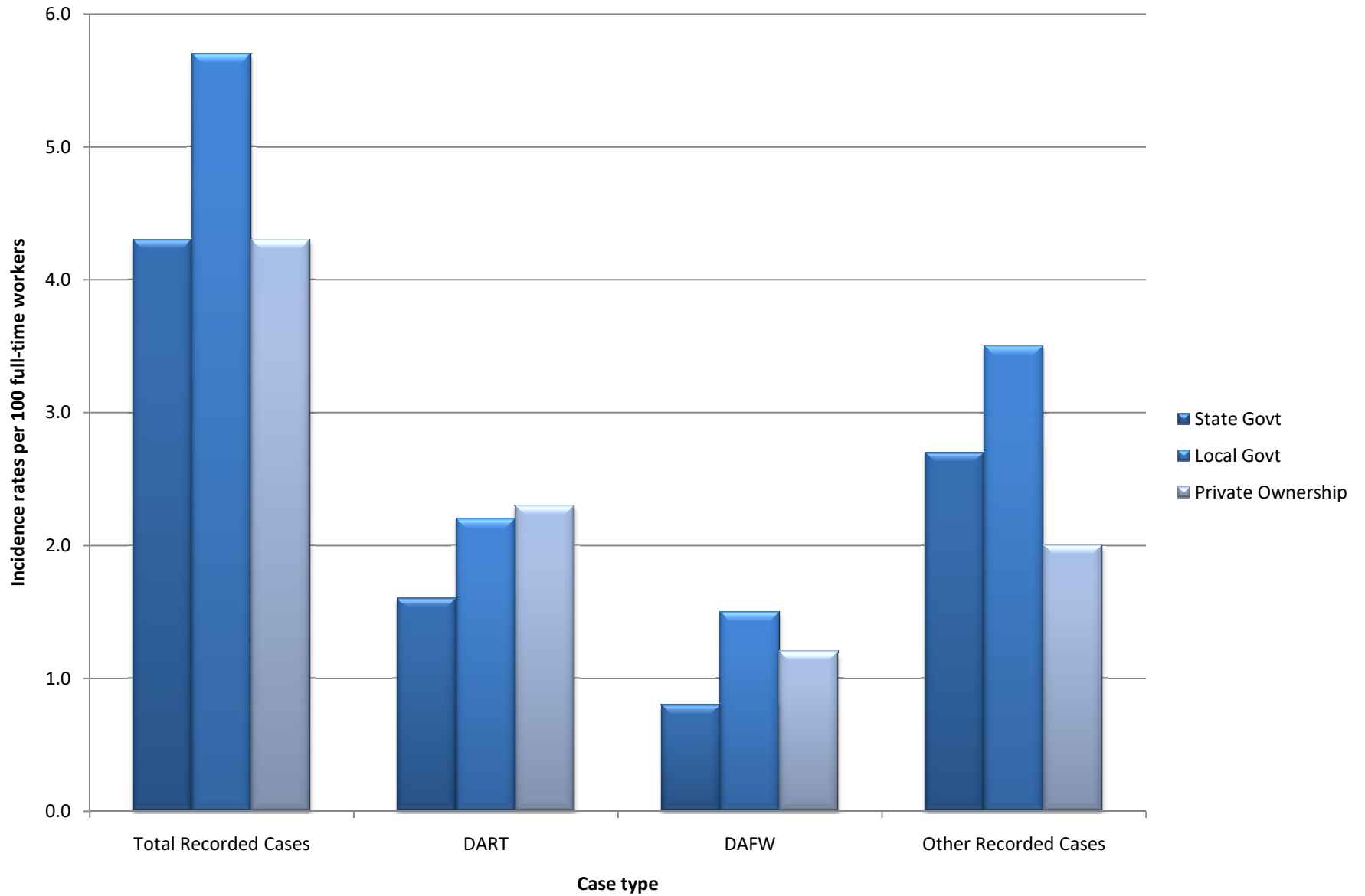

Chart 7. Number of cases with days away from work, job transfer, or restriction, by case type and private major industry sectors, state government, and local government, Nevada, 2009



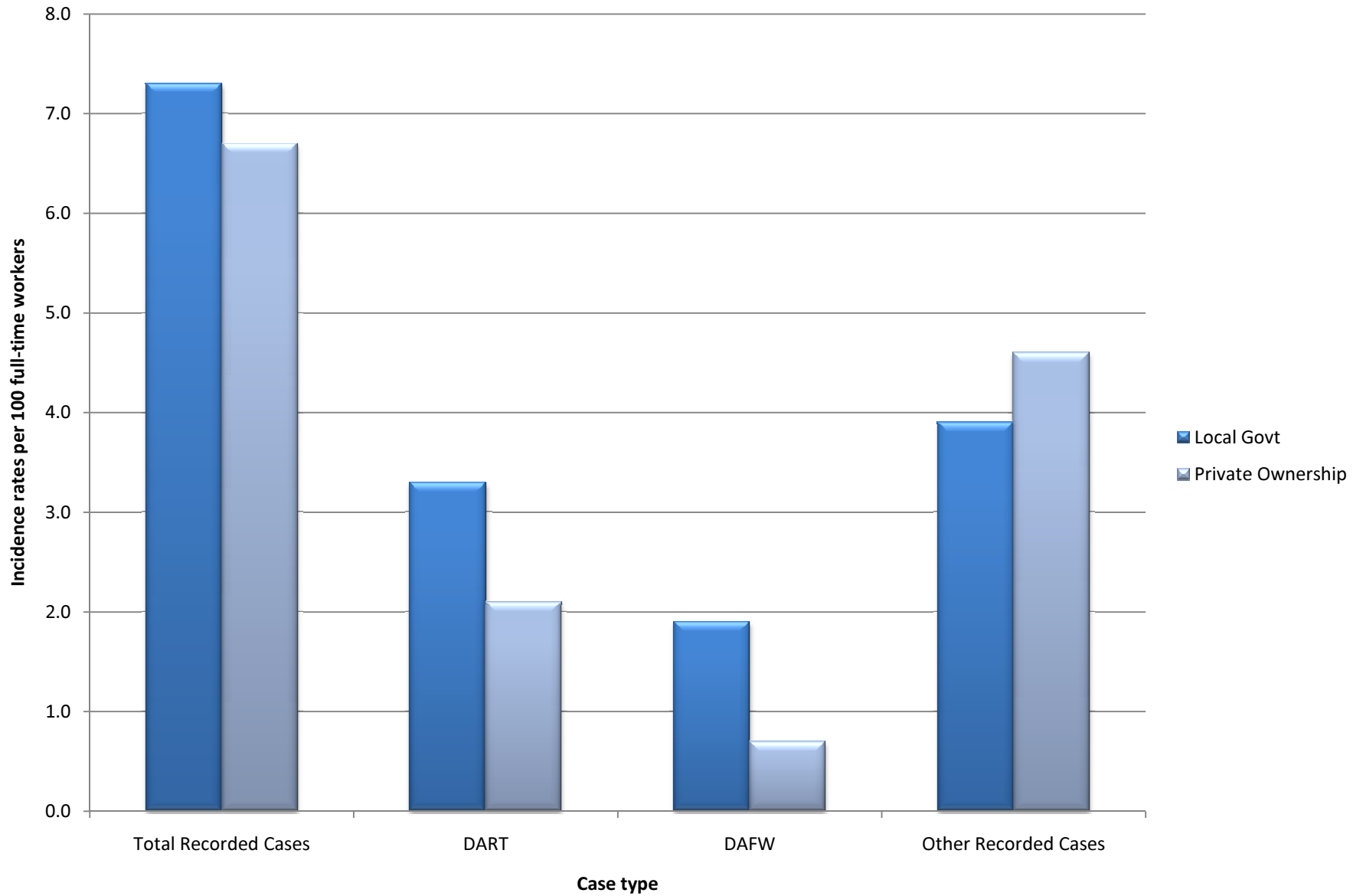

Chart 8. Incidence rates of Occupational Injuries and Illnesses by Ownership and Case Type, Nevada, 2009



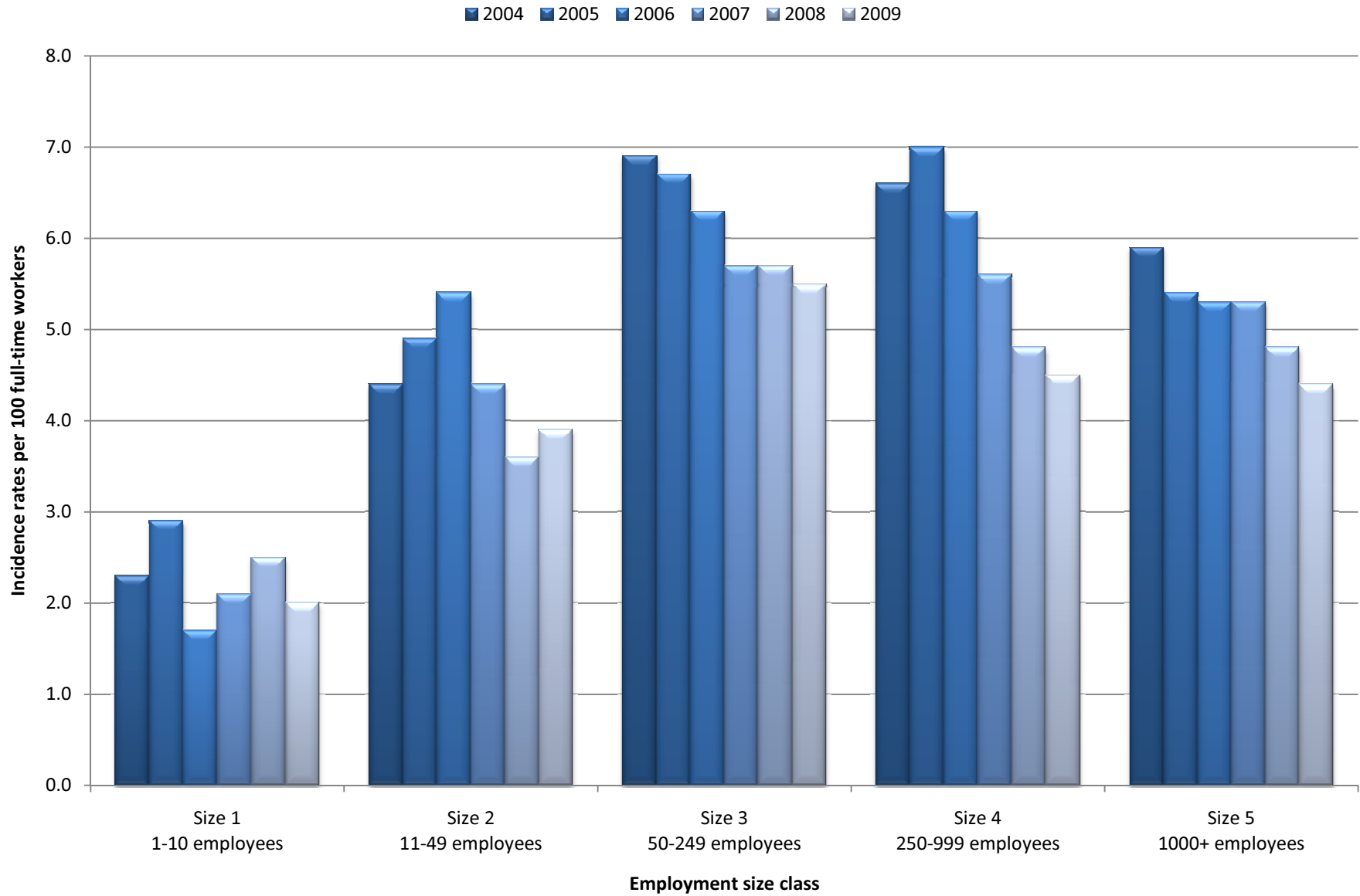
