





## **UP TO \$180,000 REWARD**

Up to \$180,000 is being offered for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the individual or individuals responsible for the shootings of Ladavionne Garrett Jr., 10, Trinity Ottoson-Smith, 9, and Aniya Allen, 6, in Minneapolis. Investigators believe all three children were the unintended victims of gun violence among rival gangs.

## Ladavionne Garrett Jr.: Shot April 30, 2021

10-year-old Ladavionne Garrett Jr. was shot and severely wounded while riding in a vehicle in the 3400 block of N. Morgan Avenue. Ladavionne remains hospitalized in critical condition.

## Trinity Ottoson-Smith: Shot May 15, 2021

9-year-old Trinity Ottoson-Smith was shot while jumping on a trampoline at a home in the 2200 block of N. Ilona Avenue. She died 12 days later.

## Aniya Allen: Shot May 17, 2021

6-year-old Aniya Allen was shot while riding in her mother's car at the intersection of N. 36th and Penn avenues. Aniya died two days later.
