Save time creating similar rules! Duplicate existing rules, then edit.

Rules organized by editor.

View and load available Rule Sets on the last tab.

Create Rules Sets from all editors or just one tab.

Same rules, just new visualization!

De-select to show only rules from selected editor.

New interface for Study Rules Editor!

Utilize same functions in a new format. Organized by editor, this update makes visualization of study rules easier.

New functions:

- **Duplicate:** copy and edit to quickly create similar rules.
- **Rule sets:** view and load rule sets in current study.
- **Pre-defined rules:** turn on/off with a simple checkbox on applicable tab.
- **Save Sets:** new option to save rules from only one editor/section.

Add predefined rules with one click!

Pre-defined Study Rules	Permission to Edit Rule
<input type="checkbox"/> Lock Trial ID as position 1 for Assessment Data Images	
<input type="checkbox"/> Limit Assessment Crop & Pest list to items selected on Site Description	
<input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Only allow selecting SEs from master database	All protocol owners

Conditional Study Rules

Apply rules *conditionally*: activate rules based on another field's contents.

Example: Require Crop Planting Rate field only when Planting Date is entered.

Field: Crop Description - Planting Rate

Permission to Edit Rule: Everyone in my company

Type: Required

Active when: Always Conditional

Edit... Crop Description - Planting Date <>

Use multiple fields or multiple values within a single field to define conditions.

Example: Require GPS Accuracy of LL Corner if:

- Site Type = Field, Orchard, OR Research Plot
- AND Trial Origin = Contracted Trial

General Trial - GPS Accuracy of LL Corner is Required when:

Condition: Site Description Site and Design - Site Type Equals FIELD + OR

ORCHAR + OR

RESPLO + OR

Header Trial Origin Equals C + OR

+ AND AND: multiple fields to evaluate

OR: multiple categories/values that rules apply to

Boost your company's "global rule sets" to address specific rules for certain trial types.

Ask GDM for help if you want to use this feature, but are uncertain how to add the correct logic!

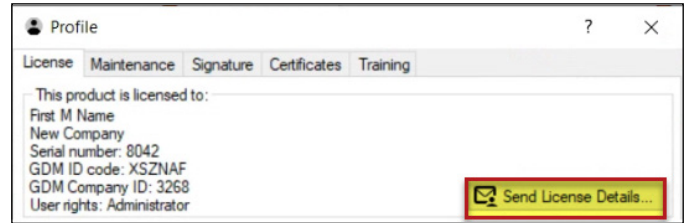

Easily Communicate Important Trial Information and Due Dates

Use the Trial Location table to plan specific trials for the current experiment. Find it in the Protocol Description - Trial Establishment Guidelines section.

Insert a new row for each individual trial or for each person organizing trials (use 'Number of Trials' if more than one trial may be assigned per person).

Two new fields: 'Interim Data Due' and 'Final Report Due' allow entry of unique due dates for each trial.

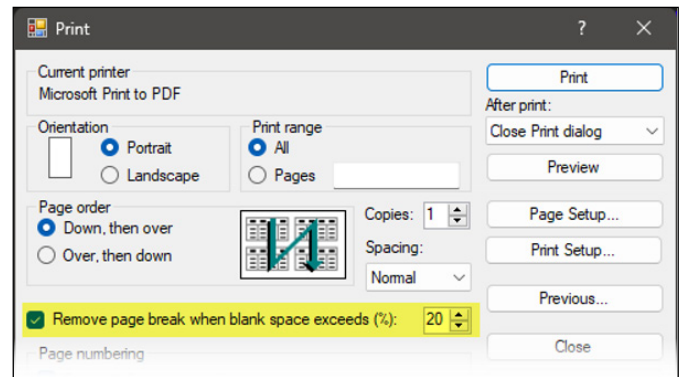

Save Space on Reports!

Select 'Remove page break...' to combine report sections on same page (if possible).

Summary reports (such as AOV means, Assessment Data Summary, etc) take up most of a page, so ARM always starts those on a new page.
