INSTRUCTIONS FOR SPECIAL SPOT ADMISSION

1. Candidates for B Tech Programmes with CAT 2024 rank can attend the SPOT admission as scheduled below.

- 2. **Individual call letter will not be sent to the candidates**. Candidates should register at the venue before 10 am on the date of Spot Admission (as per the schedule). Candidates who do not report before 10.00 am at the venue will not be considered for spot admission.
- 3. Candidates eligible for registering to Special Spot Admission.
 - i. Candidates who did not receive any allotment so far.
 - ii. Candidates who have received allotment and wish to change to a different program.
 - iii. Candidates who did not register their options earlier.
 - iv. Candidates who received allotment earlier and cancelled their allotment.
 - v. Candidates who received allotment earlier and rejected by the Department (not because of eligibility).
 - vi. Candidates who received allotment earlier and not remitted the requisite fee.
- 4. Candidates not eligible for registering to Special Spot Admission.
 - i. Candidates who took admission in previous spot admissions and not remitted the requisitefee/balance fee.
 - ii. Candidates who received allotment earlier and rejected by the Department because of ineligibility).
- 5. Candidates who did not claim the benefits of reservations (Communal Reservation/ Special Reservation etc.) during online application (by mistake) can now claim the reservation benefits during Spot admission with supporting documents. For claiming NRI, CGW seats in special spot admission, candidates (those who have not opted for the same during the application process) have to remit an additional amount of Rs.5000/-(Rupees Five Thousand Only) along with the requisite fee.
- 6. There will be multiple rounds in the special spot admissions (depending on vacancy). Admission to all generated/cancelled vacancies during the special Spot Admission will be considered in the subsequent rounds. Once admission is taken in a particular branch during the Special Spot Admission, no further Cancellation / Change of branches is allowed in the subsequent rounds.
- 7. Candidates are also advised to check the seat balance published in the admission website https://admissions.cusat.ac.in before attending the Spot Admission.

- 8. Read the Prospectus published in the website https://admissions.cusat.ac.in and make sure that the candidate fulfills the required eligibility criteria.
- 9. Programmes will be allotted to the candidates who registered for spot admission, strictly on the basis of the **CAT rank**.
- 10. Candidate who accepts admission in spot admission, his/her previous allotment/admission, if any, will be cancelled automatically.
- 11. Candidates who have already received allotment and completed the fees payment and accept spot admission to a different program in the same fee category, his/her earlier allotment will automatically be cancelled.
- 12. Candidates who have already received allotment and completed the fees payment and accept spot admission to a different program of the higher fee category need to remit the balance fee immediately, failing which their new allotment and their previous allotment will be cancelled automatically.
- 13. Non-Keralite candidates are not eligible for communal reservation.
- 14. Candidates coming for spot admission should remit the required fee immediately after the allotment (through online only). The fee payment will be enabled in the candidate profile immediately.
- 15. If a candidate fails to remit the fees, the admission will be summarily cancelled without further notice.
- 16. The candidate can proceed to document verification after completing the fee payment.
- 17. The candidates need to pay the additional fees of PTA/DDF/Alumni etc., at the time of verification by the Department.

18. The following certificates/documents should be submitted in original at the time of counseling/admission.

- CAT 2024 Admit Card/Online application Registration Confirmation Page/Provisional Admit Card.
- Migration Certificate (for students who studied from institutions outside Kerala state)
- S.S.L.C/10th Mark list & pass certificate (CBSE, ICSE etc.).
- Plus 2 Mark lists / and pass certificate (CBSE, ICSE etc.).
- Certificate to prove Keralite Status, for State Merit Seats
- Transfer Certificate and Conduct Certificate from the Institution last attended (in English version)
- Four passport size Photographs of the candidate
- Non-Creamy Layer certificate in the case of 'SEBC' candidates, issued by Village Officer.
- Community certificate issued by the Tahsildar in the case of Kerala Scheduled Caste (KSC)/ Kerala Scheduled Tribe (KST)candidates.
- Candidates seeking admission under physically challenged (PHC) category should invariably produce a valid Physically Handicapped certificate issued by the District Medical Board of the State to which the candidate belongs.
- If any of the above certificates are not in English/Malayalam, Candidates should invariably produce a translated version of the same in English endorsed by a Notary Public.
- Two sets of self-attested copies of all the original certificates/documents mentioned above.
- Proof for Special Reservation, if any (DAC, NRI, CGW, CHD, EWS, IDC, AND, TG etc)
- Annexure II Declaration to be submitted by Candidate stating Nationality (duly filled)- (only for outside Kerala Candidates)
- 19. Candidates claiming the Keralite status should invariably produce, at the time of counseling/ admission, any one of the following certificates.
 - The certificate of Birth / Residence of the candidate or his/her father or mother from the Village Officer / Tahsildar or from a competent authority of local body, OR
 - The 'Certificate showing school studies in Kerala from Standards VIII to XII' from the Head of School where the candidate completed his / her study in Standard XII, OR

- True copy of the relevant page of the SSLC of the candidate's father / mother showing the place of birth in Kerala with corroborative evidence showing the relationship between the candidate and the parent, OR
- True copy of the relevant page of the passport of the candidate or either of parents issued by the Government of India showing place of birth in Kerala with corroborative evidence showing the relationship between the parent and candidate, OR
- True copy of birth certificate of candidate or his / her, father / mother showing the place of birth in Kerala with corroborative evidence showing the relationship between the candidate and father / mother of whose birth certificate is being produced For claiming Keralite-AIS (All India Service), certificate from competent authority should be attached.

The candidates joining CUSAT shall sign the following declarations at the time of admission:

- It has been suggested by the UGC that an anti-drug declaration be taken from the students at the time of admission to invoke a commitment from the students to have responsible behaviour during studies (Annexure III)
- It is compulsory for each and every student and parent to submit an online undertaking every academic year at https://antiragging.in/affidavit_university_form.php. The students will receive an e-mail with his/her registration number. The anti-ragging undertaking reference number should be provided to the department at the time of admission/verification. Also downloaded copy of the anti-ragging undertaking duly signed by the deponents (student and parent) should submit to the concerned department before commencement of the classes.
- An Anti dowry declaration has to be signed by the students at the time of admission(Annexure IV)
- 20. The University reserves the right to add, delete or amend any of the stipulations regarding eligibility, intake, specialization, type of programmes, rules, regulations, fee structure etc. at any time and these will be applicable to the candidates seeking admission.
