The technical workshop is part of the project *Voluntary Local Reviews: Evidence for Greener, Resilient and Sustainable Urban Recovery in Eastern European and Central Asian Countries in Transition.* The project aims to advance socio-economic recovery from the COVID-19 pandemic and SDG localization in Eastern European and Central Asian countries in transition by harnessing the potential of Voluntary Local Reviews (VLRs).

Background

Responding to both COVID-19 and the SDGs have strong local dimensions. Since COVID-19 affects urban neighborhoods and groups of people in cities differently, addressing it requires a granular, localized understanding of cities and local realities. Measures to reduce virus transmission, including the implementation of lockdowns, are also highly localized and economic recovery strategies are locally designed and implemented. Meanwhile, according to the OECD, at least 105 of the 169 SDGs targets (62 per cent) will not be reached without proper engagement and coordination with local and regional governments. Thus, effective recovery from COVID-19 coupled with the achievement of SDGs requires increased localized action. SDG localization is hence understood as the process of transforming the Global Goals into reality at the local level, for local communities and their environments, in coordination with national frameworks; it is a two-way process where the local meets the national and the global and vice-versa, and where all parts of society come together, joining hands, visions and resources towards a common objective – the achievement of sustainable, inclusive and resilient development.

Voluntary Local Reviews (VLRs) represent a unique tool to foster the link between the SDGs and the COVID-19 recovery. VLRs are a powerful accelerator of SDG localization: they have the

potential to reinforce data environments at the local level; to bring residents, including marginalized groups, closer to decision-making processes; to strengthen multilevel governance and inform the elaboration of Voluntary National Reviews; and to foster local planning, while providing evidence for the design of COVID-19 recovery plans and priority interventions both at local and national levels.

The project objective is to advance socio-economic recovery and SDG localization in Eastern Europe and Central Asian countries in transition by harnessing the potential of Voluntary Local Reviews.

It proposes to do so by connecting the expertise, approaches and work of key international partners that have been working to promote VLRs and SDG localization in the past years: UNHabitat; UNECE; UNDESA and UCLG.

Pilot cities and countries will be directly supported to **develop their VLR and to pilot the Global Urban Monitoring Framework** – the UN framework to monitor the local implementation of the SDGs and New Urban Agenda. The VLR will be "recovery" oriented, being inspired by the Rapid Response project and methodology led by UNECE and the UNRECS, with the support of UNHabitat and UNCDF.

The VLR will be the basis to **launch the SDG localization process within the cities, specifically inspired by the <u>SDG Cities</u> cycle** aimed that links VLRs with City Development Strategies, projects development and investments.

In addition, local and regional representatives from pilot cities and countries will be part involved in **capacity building proces**s based on the <u>SDG Learning Modules</u> led by UCLG, UN-Habitat and other implementing partners.

Last but not least, thought the project, pilot cities and countries' representatives will be **participating (virtually or in person) to the key regional and international events** on Sustainable Development including the Regional Forums on Sustainable Development, the UN-Habitat Assembly, HLPF, the SDG Summit and World Urban Forum 2024.
