

# Orlando, FL, Area Economic Summary


Over-the-year changes in employment on nonfarm payrolls and employment by major industry sector








Over-the-year change in the prices paid by urban consumers for selected categories




# 12-month percent change in CPI-U, July 2024






Employer costs per hour worked for wages and
