
Fort Smith Area Economic Summary


Over-the-year changes in employment on nonfarm payrolls and employment by major industry sector






Over-the-year change in the prices paid by urban consumers for selected categories






Average annual spending and percent distribution for selected categories

selected employee benefits by geographic division




Average hourly wages for selected occupations
