

# Oklahoma City Area Economic Summary

Over-the-year changes in employment on nonfarm payrolls and employment by major industry sector






Over-the-year change in the prices paid by urban consumers for selected categories

#### 12-month percent change in CPI-U, June 2024




Average annual spending and percent distribution for selected categories


