The Italian Presidency of the G7 is honoured to host the Summit of G7 Heads of State and Government, to be held at Borgo Egnazia, in the municipality of Fasano (Brindisi) in Italy's Puglia Region, from Thursday 13 June to Saturday 15 June.

Please find below some practical information for media representatives, last updated on **13 June** and subject to modification.

VENUES

The Summit of G7 Heads of State and Government will be held at Borgo Egnazia (BR), in Italy's Puglia Region.

- Borgo Egnazia resort → Summit Venue
- Fiera del Levante exhibition centre in BARI → Media-Broadcasting Centre

A maximum-security area covering the entire resort of Borgo Egnazia will be set up as a 'red zone'. For security reasons, it will not be possible to access the Summit venue by private vehicle. Within the red zone, specially designated vehicles will mainly be used to move around. Please note that only authorised categories will be allowed to enter this area (NO journalists-photographers and TV crews).

INTERNATIONAL MEDIA AND BROADCASTING CENTRE

The International **Media Centre** will provide workspaces and TV booths for media representatives and will be located at the **Fiera del Levante exhibition centre (70132 Bari).** The opening times are as follows:

POOLS Departure from the Media Centre is scheduled at 09:00 on 14 June. The meeting point is the Information Desk. For logistical reasons, participants in pool 5 and pool 7 cannot participate in pool 6 and vice versa.

ONLY photographers and camera operators will be allowed, with the exception of the final press conference which will also be open to journalists.

Pool members will receive a pool card that is only valid for that specific pool/photo-video opportunity.

As per the above table, members of a given pool will not be able to be part of other pools on the same day.

Photographers and camera operators will be accompanied back to the Media Centre after each pool/photo-video opportunity.

Live stand ups / live broadcasts ARE NOT ALLOWED in the vicinity of Borgo Egnazia and the Golf Club.

INFORMATION FOR TV AND RADIO OPERATORS

Rai Radiotelevisione Italiana (RAI) is the Host Broadcaster for the Italian Presidency of the G7 2024.

RAI, in collaboration with the European Broadcasting Union (EBU), will provide broadcasters and press agencies with audiovisual material on the occasion of the Summit of Heads of State and Government to be held in Puglia from 13th to 15th June 2024.

The collaboration between RAI and the EBU will facilitate the participating colleagues to create their own editorial services by providing access to technical and logistical infrastructures.

In order to ensure the best and most complete coverage possible for all media guests, the allocation and management of technical and logistical services will be handled by:

- RAI for all Italian radio and television broadcasters;
- EBU for all foreign radio and television broadcasters / TV agencies and pools

The available services will be assigned on the principle of "first come, first served", and the relevant rate card will be provided upon request.

EVENT COVERAGE

RAI will produce coverage of the events in HD-SDI 1080/50i format with embedded audio.

The live broadcast signal will be distributed via satellite and live streaming. The coordinates are available at this <u>link</u>.

The signals of the G7 Heads of State and Government Summit will be made available as follows:

- a primary signal, that will offer a broad live coverage of the main events (arrivals of the Heads of State and Government, "handshake", "round the table", "family photo", final press conferences of the participating States), through the fiber and satellite circuits of EBU's Global Eurovision Network, at the RAI Rome CNCT and at the IBC at Fiera del Levante in Bari;
- a secondary signal for any simultaneous event, ENG contributions and highlights at the RAI Rome CNCT and at the IBC at Fiera del Levante.

INTERNATIONAL BROADCASTING CENTRE (IBC)

RAI and EBU will manage the services for the broadcasters hosted at the IBC inside the International Media Centre located at the Fiera del Levante exhibition centre (Lungomare Starita, 4, 70132 Bari).

WORKSPACES

Partitioned workspaces (equipped with basic furniture, power, RJ45 internet connection and HD-SDI pool access through BNC cable) will be available for international media at the IBC. A shared WI-FI connection is available in all work areas of the IBC.

Reservation will be handled on the basis of the "first come, first served" principle.

LIVE STAND-UP POSITIONS

Stand-up positions (equipped with basic lighting, power and RJ45 internet connection) will be managed on a "first come, first served" basis.

For safety reasons, any cabling must be previously checked and agreed with RAI / EBU.

EBU will also be offering bookable fully equipped and manned live positions.

PARKING FOR SNG/UPLINK

There will be a limited number of spaces available for SNG / Uplink vehicle parking in the satellite farm. These spaces will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis.

All vehicles will be subjected to security checks before entering the satellite farm.

Media interested in using technical equipment in Italy that use radio frequencies must request a temporary license from the competent Authority.

The Ministry of Enterprises and Made in Italy (MIMIT) is the entity responsible for issuing the aforementioned licenses.

MIMIT and RAI Way will ensure coordination and support for frequencies and will provide monitoring for the duration of the event.
