## **RULING AND ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

On May 21, 2010, the Secretary filed a motion to dismiss this action against Petitioner. The Secretary states that the debt in this case pertains to the same debt in another case already pending before this court. Specifically, the Secretary states that the previously-filed case is "10-M-CH-LL94 and the claim number identifying the debt the Secretary is seeking to collect is "7-71047005 OB." Secretary's Motion to Dismiss, ¶1. Based on a letter from Petitioner, dated April 29, 2010, that Petitioner forwarded to the court, rather than to the HUD Financial Operations Center in Albany, N.Y., "the Court issued a second Notice of Docketing, Order, and Stay of Referral (Order) under case number 10-M-CH-LL136." Secretary's Motion to Dismiss, ¶2. Since both cases clearly pertain to the same debt, and without objection, the Secretary's Motion to Dismiss is GRANTED. Accordingly, it is

**ORDERED** that this case is DISMISSED, without prejudice to the Secretary's ability to seek collection of the debt identified as HUD claim no. 7-71047005 OB and docketed as HUD Office of Appeals Case No. 10-M-CH-LL94.
