RULING AND ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On March 12, 2010, the Secretary filed a motion to dismiss this action against Petitioner. The Secretary states that "Petitioner forwarded the Secretary documentary evidence that he could not have taken out the loan on which the Secretary is seeking indemnification. (Exhibit A) & (Exhibit B)" Secretary's Motion to Dismiss, ¶2. The Secretary further states that he is "satisfied with Petitioner's claim that he is not responsible [for] repay[ment of] this loan and no longer has any intent to offset Petitioner['s] tax returns." *Id.*, ¶3. Without objection, and for good cause shown, the Secretary's Motion to Dismiss is GRANTED. Accordingly, it is

ORDERED that this case is DISMISSED, with prejudice.
