ORDER GRANTING DISMISSAL

On March 18, 2022, the Court received Petitioner's request for a hearing concerning the Secretary's intent to seek repayment of a debt allegedly owed to the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD"). Then, on March 24, 2022, the Court issued the *Notice of Docketing, Order, and Stay of Referral* to the Parties.

The Secretary now moves for dismissal of the matter with prejudice because Petitioner's debt was paid in full by Petitioner's co-debtor in January 2022. The Secretary adds that they will no longer pursue collection via Administrative Offset or otherwise.

It is unclear why the Secretary did not move for dismissal of the matter upon receipt of Petitioner's *Hearing Request* or the Court's *Notice of Docketing*. Nevertheless, the Secretary has demonstrated good cause and this matter is **DISMISSED**.
