ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On December 5, 2023, Petitioner requested a hearing concerning the existence, amount, or enforceability of a debt allegedly owed to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (“HUD” or the “Secretary”). On December 11, 2023, the Court issued a *Notice of Docketing, Order, and Stay of Referral* scheduling a hearing limited to a review of the written record and ordering the Parties to submit documentary evidence and statements in support of their positions.

While Petitioner timely responded, no response was received from HUD. Thus, on February 20, 2024, the Court issued an *Order for HUD to Show Cause Why This Case Should Not Be Dismissed*. In response, on February 21, 2024, HUD moved for dismissal by filing the *Secretary’s Motion to Dismiss*, wherein HUD states that the Secretary has determined that HUD had received the full payment.

CONCLUSION AND ORDER

For the foregoing reasons, the *Secretary’s Motion to Dismiss* is granted. This proceeding is hereby dismissed.
