
ORDER GRANTING DISMISSAL

On September 17, 2014, the Secretary filed a *Motion to Dismiss* seeking to dismiss, without prejudice, its action to pursue collection of the subject debt via administrative offset because “the debt is not legally enforceable against Petitioner at this time because the Petitioner filed a Chapter 7 Bankruptcy Petition (Petitioner #93-45076) before the U.S. Bankruptcy Court, Central District of California, and received a discharge on July 31, 1996, which included the debt that is the subject of this action.” Upon due consideration, the *Motion to Dismiss* is **GRANTED**.

The Secretary shall not seek to collect the claimed debt of Petitioner by means of administrative offset. The Order imposing the stay of referral of this matter to the U.S. Department of the Treasury for administrative offset shall remain in place indefinitely.

This matter of HUDOHA #14-VH-0114-AO-007 is **DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE**.
