RULING AND ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On June 16, 2015, Petitioner was ordered to file documentary evidence, on or before July 16, 2015, to prove that Petitioner was not indebted to HUD in the amounts claimed by the Secretary. *Notice of Docketing, Order, and Stay of Referral*, dated June 16, 2015. Petitioner failed to comply with that *Order*. On October 5, 2015 Petitioner was again ordered to file documentary evidence, on or before October 26, 2015, to support her appeal in this case. The *October 5, 2015 Order* specifically stated that: “Failure to comply with this Order may result in the entry of judgment in favor of the opposing party in this case or the imposition of other possible sanctions in accordance with the discretion of the Administrative Judge.” Petitioner also failed to comply with the *October 5, 2015 Order*. To date, Petitioner has failed to file any documentary evidence in support of her case. Accordingly, the Court rules *sua sponte* that Petitioner’s appeal in this case should be dismissed. Therefore, it is

ORDERED that this case is DISMISSED *with prejudice*, and the stay of referral of this matter to the U.S. Department of the Treasury, previously issued on June 16, 2015, is hereby VACATED.
