## **RULING AND ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

On October 14, 2015, Petitioners filed their response to the Order for Documentary Evidence, dated October 5, 2015. Petitioners' response moved to dismiss this appeal and attached a letter from the HUD Financial Operations Center purporting to release Petitioners from the alleged debt to HUD in this case. On January 27, 2016, this Court issued an order to the Secretary to show cause why this case should not be dismissed. On February 18, 2016, the Secretary filed the Secretary's Response to Order to Show Cause, stating that "HUD has acknowledged receipt of payment in full of Petitioner's debt." ¶5. The Government further states that "HUD had no objection to the Petitioner's request regarding her case because her debt has been paid in full." Id, ¶4.

Upon consideration of *Petitioner's Motion to Dismiss*, and the Secretary's response conceding that Petitioners are no longer indebted to the Department, *Petitioners' Motion to Dismiss* is GRANTED. Therefore, it is

**ORDERED** that this administrative offset claim is DISMISSED, with prejudice. The Stay of Referral of this matter to the U.S. Department of the Treasury for collection, issued on September 17, 2015, shall remain in place, indefinitely.
