## ORDER GRANTING PETITIONER'S MOTION TO DISMISS

On January 13, 2016, Petitioner filed, in response to the Court's *Order for Clarification*, what the Court deemed to be a *Motion to Dismiss (Motion)*. In the *Motion*, Petitioner stated that he had entered into an agreement with the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for a monthly payment plan of \$250.00 per month for the subject debt.

The Secretary later filed, on February 26, 2016, a Secretary's Response to the [Order] for Documentary Evidence in which the Secretary stated that the parties had in fact entered into a repayment agreement, and that Petitioner had agreed to pay \$250.00 on a monthly basis. Therefore, without objection, the Petitioner's Motion to Dismiss is **GRANTED**. It is hereby

**ORDERED** that this matter be **DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE**. However, the Secretary shall reserve the right to seek collection by administrative offset and other means available under the law should Petitioner default under the terms of the repayment agreement.

The stay of referral of this matter to the U.S. Department of the Treasury, issued by this Court on August 5, 2015, shall remain in place until such time as Petitioner defaults under the terms of the repayment agreement.
