## **ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

Title 24 of the Code of Federal Regulations. Section 17.69 (b) provides that failure by the Petitioner to submit evidence within 60 calendar days from the date of the Department's Notice of Intent will result in a dismissal of Petitioner's request for review by the Court.

Upon requesting of the Court documentation related to the alleged debt, Petitioner was informed that such documentation was not in the possession of the Court. Petitioner was directed to where she could submit her request. See *Notice of Docketing*, dated December 19, 2016; *Order for Documentary Evidence*, dated March 2, 2016. Petitioner also was ordered, on January 11, 2016 and March 2, 2016. to submit documentary evidence in support of her position. Without such evidence from Petitioner, Petitioner remains legally obligated to pay the alleged debt in the amount so claimed by the Secretary.

To date. Petitioner has failed to comply with any of the Court's Orders and also has failed to show cause why this Court should not enter a judgment in favor of the Secretary.

Therefore, consistent with the provisions of 24 C.F.R. § 17.69 (b). Petitioner's appeal is now **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE** *sua sponte*.
