RULING AND ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On April 4, 2017, this court ordered Petitioner to file the appropriate creditor's schedule demonstrating that Petitioner's alleged debt to HUD, or its predecessor-in-interest, was listed as a creditor in the bankruptcy proceeding, by May 5, 2017, in the above-captioned docket. Petitioner failed to do so.


On November 20, 2017, Petitioner was ordered to file "documentary evidence which will prove Petitioner's alleged debt to HUD, or its predecessor-in-interest, was listed as a creditor in the bankruptcy proceeding." *Order*, dated November 20, 2017. Petitioner failed to comply with the November 20th *Order*.

On February 6, 2018, the Office of Hearings and Appeals ("OHA") issued an *Order To Show Cause* ("*Show Cause*"). The *Show Cause* asked Petitioner to respond by February 10, 2018, and provide evidence as to why Petitioner's appeal should not be dismissed with judgment being entered in favor of the Secretary on the grounds that Petitioner has failed to comply with the Court's *Orders* in this case. Petitioner failed to respond to the *Show Cause*. Therefore, it is

ORDERED that this appeal is **DISMISSED**, *sua sponte*, and *with prejudice*. It is

FURTHER ORDERED that the Stay of Referral previously entered in this case on April 4, 2017 is hereby **VACATED**.
