RULING AND ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On April 17, 2017, Petitioner was ordered to file documentary evidence on or before May 17, 2017, to support her appeal in this case. *Notice of Docketing, Order, and Stay of Referral*, dated April 17, 2017. Petitioner failed to comply with that *Order*.

On December 5, 2017, Petitioner was again ordered to file, on or before January 5, 2018, "documentary evidence which will prove that all or part of the alleged debt is either unenforceable or not past due." *Order*, dated December 5, 2017. Petitioner also failed to comply with the December 5th *Order*.

On January 10, 2018, the Office of Hearings and Appeals ("OHA") issued an *Order To Show Cause* ("Show Cause"). The Show Cause asked Petitioner to respond by February 10, 2018, and provide evidence as to why Petitioner's appeal should not be dismissed with judgment being entered in favor of the Secretary on the grounds that Petitioner has failed to comply with the Court's *Orders* in this case. Petitioner failed to respond to the Show Cause. Therefore, it is

ORDERED that this appeal is **DISMISSED**, with prejudice. It is

FURTHER ORDERED that the Stay of Referral previously entered in this case on September 12, 2017 is hereby **VACATED**.
