ORDER OF DISMISSAL

In 24 C.F.R. § 26.4 (c) it provides that failure by the Petitioner to submit evidence within 60 calendar days from the date of the Department's Notice of Intent, will result in a dismissal of Petitioner's request for review by the HUD Office of Appeals.

On December 27, 2016, Petitioner alleged in her *Request for Hearing* that, "I hereby request a copy of the HUD records related to the debt said to be owed. I am unaware of any debt owed and have to contact Luis Madera several times by phone with [no] return call." To date, Petitioner has been ordered three times, on December 29, 2016, February 2, 2017, and March 6, 2017, to submit documentary evidence in support of her claim, but has failed to comply. Petitioner was also informed that if she needed additional information, "Documents relating to this alleged debt are not in the possession of this Court. Petitioner may request copies of these documents by writing to: Cheryl Dobert, U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, Financial Operations Center, 52 Corporate Circle, Albany, NY 12203." Finally, Petitioner was informed that, "Failure to comply with this Order shall result in sanctions being imposed by the Court pursuant to 24 C.F.R. § 26.4 (c), including judgment being entered on behalf of the opposing party."

Upon due consideration of Petitioner's failure to comply, and consistent with the provisions set forth in 24 C.F.R. § 26.4 (c), Petitioner's appeal is **DISMISSED** *sua sponte*. It is hereby

ORDERED that this matter be DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE.

The stay of referral of this matter to the U.S. Department of the Treasury issued on December 27, 2016 is hereby VACATED.
