ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Title 24 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Section 17.69 (b) provides that failure by the Petitioner to submit evidence within 60 calendar days from the date of the Department's Notice of Intent will result in a dismissal of Petitioner's request for review by the Court. In addition, failure to comply with Orders issued by the Court shall result in sanctions being imposed by the Court pursuant to 24 C.F.R. § 26.4 (c), including judgment being entered on behalf of the opposing party.

Upon requesting of the Court documentation related to the alleged debt, Petitioner was informed that such documentation was not in the possession of the Court. On January 11, 2017, in her *Notice of Docketing*, Petitioner was directed to where she could submit her request for documentation. Petitioner also was ordered, on February 24, 2017 and April 4, 2017, to submit documentary evidence in support of her position. To date, Petitioner has failed to comply with any of the Court's Orders and has failed to show cause why this Court should not enter a judgment in favor of the Secretary.

Therefore, consistent with the provisions of 24 C.F.R. §§ 17.69 (b) and 26.4(c), Petitioner's appeal is now **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE** *sua sponte*.
