ORDER OF DISMISSAL


In 24 C.F.R. §§17.69 (b) and 26.4 (c) it provides, in general, that failure by the Petitioner to submit evidence within 60 calendar days from the date of the Department's Notice of Intent will result in a dismissal of Petitioner's request for review by the HUD Office of Hearings and Appeals.

On April 4, 2017, Petitioner alleged in her *Request for Hearing* that "The agreement that was made with Admiral Bank was payment to this account be every two weeks starting January 2017. This debt would be paid off no later than March 2018." No evidence was filed in support of Petitioner's claim that the subject debt owed to HUD would be paid off, or that Petitioner was released from her obligation for the alleged debt. To date, Petitioner has failed to comply with any of the Court's *Orders* to produce such evidence that HUD, not Admiral Bank, issued her a written release from the subject debt. See Order to Show Cause dated June 21, 2017.

Consistent with the provisions of 24 C.F.R. §§ 17.69 (b) and 26.4 (c), Petitioner's appeal is **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE** *sua sponte* also because of Petitioner's non-compliance with the Court's *Orders* to produce sufficient evidence for the Court's review.

The stay of proceeding issued on April 5, 2017 is hereby VACATED.
