RULING AND ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On October 25, 2017, this court ordered Petitioners to file documentary evidence by November 25, 2017, in the above-captioned docket which will prove that all or part of the alleged debt is either unenforceable or not past due. Petitioners failed to do so.

On February 26, 2018, Petitioners were ordered to file "documentary evidence which will prove that all or part of the alleged debt is either unenforceable or not past due," on or before March 26, 2018. *Order*, dated February 26, 2018. Petitioners failed to comply with the February 26th *Order*.

On March 28, 2018, Petitioners were ordered to file documentary evidence again, no later than April 28, 2018, or to show cause why this appeal should not be dismissed for want of prosecution. That *Order* specifically stated that: "Failure to comply with this Order shall result in the immediate entry of judgment in favor of the opposing party or in the imposition of such other sanctions as the Administrative Judge deems necessary or appropriate in this case. See 24 C.F.R. §26.4(d)." (Emphasis in original). Petitioner also failed to comply with the *Order to Show Cause*. Now therefore, it is

ORDERED that this case is **DISMISSED**, without prejudice. It is

FURTHER ORDERED that the Stay of Referral previously entered in this case on October 25, 2017 is hereby **VACATED**.
