## **RULING AND ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

On November 7, 2017, this court ordered Petitioner to file documentary evidence by January 6, 2018, in the above-captioned docket which will prove that all or part of the alleged debt is either unenforceable or not past due. Petitioner failed to do so.

On February 26, 2018, Petitioner was ordered to file "documentary evidence which will show that Petitioner's ex-husband has assumed liability for the debt at issue," on or before March 26, 2018. *Order*, dated February 26, 2018. Petitioner failed to comply with the February 26<sup>th</sup> *Order*.

Finally, on March 29, 2018, a *Show Cause Order* was issued against Petitioner directing Petitioner to file documentary evidence in support of Petitioner's appeal, or to show cause why this case should not be dismissed. Petitioner was specifically advised that: "Failure to comply with this Order shall result in the immediate entry of judgment in favor of the opposing party or in the imposition of such other sanctions as the Administrative Judge deems necessary or appropriate in this case. See 24 C.F.R. §26.4(d)." (emphasis in original). Petitioner failed to comply with the March 29, 2018 *Show Cause Order*. Therefore, it is

**ORDERED** that this case is **DISMISSED**, without prejudice. It is

**FURTHER ORDERED** that the Stay of Referral previously entered in this case on March 29, 2018 is hereby **VACATED**.
