
RULING AND ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On March 14, 2018, the Court ordered Petitioners to file documentary evidence, on or before April 13, 2018, in support of Petitioners' appeal. *Notice of Docketing, Order, and Stay of Referral*, dated March 14, 2018. Petitioners failed to comply with that *Order*. On December 19, 2018, Petitioners were issued a *Show Cause Order*, again directing Petitioners to file documentary evidence in support of their case on or before January 22, 2019. The *Show Cause Order* specifically stated that "Failure to comply with this Order shall result in the immediate entry of judgment in favor of the opposing party or in the imposition of such other sanctions as the Administrative Judge deems necessary or appropriate in this case. See 24 C.F.R. §26.4(d)." (emphasis in original). Petitioners again failed to comply with the *Order* to file documentary evidence in support of their case. Therefore, it is

ORDERED that Petitioners' appeal is hereby **DISMISSED**, *sua sponte*, and *without prejudice*. It is

FURTHER ORDERED that the *Stay of Referral* previously entered in this case on March 14, 2018, is hereby **VACATED**.
