
ORDER GRANTING DISMISSAL

On October 27, 2017, the Secretary filed a *Motion to Dismiss* and documentary evidence seeking to dismiss, without prejudice, its action to pursue collection of the subject debt by means of administrative offset. The Secretary stated that Petitioner entered into a Repayment Agreement with HUD to satisfy the subject debt. Upon due consideration, and for good cause shown, the *Motion to Dismiss* is **GRANTED**.

HUD shall retain the right to resume debt collection activities in the future, by means of administrative wage garnishment, or otherwise, should Petitioner fail to adhere to the terms of the Agreement. The stay of referral shall remain in place unless Petitioner fails to adhere to the terms of the Agreement.

The matter of HUDOHA # 18-VH-0037-AO-007 is **DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE**.
