ORDER GRANTING DISMISSAL

On January 19, 2018, the Secretary filed a *Motion to Dismiss (Motion)* seeking to dismiss, with prejudice, its action to pursue collection of the subject debt via Administrative Offset because Petitioner filed a Chapter 13 bankruptcy petition in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Maryland on April 7, 2010, which was later converted to a no asset Chapter 7 bankruptcy proceeding on July 23, 2010. Petitioner's indebtedness to HUD was thereafter discharged on November 8, 2010.
