
**ORDER GRANTING DISMISSAL**

On November 6, 2018, the Secretary filed a *Motion to Dismiss* seeking to dismiss its action to pursue collection of the subject debt by means of administrative offset because “HUD’s subordinate Notes dated January 9, 2004 and October 6, 2004 are not yet due or payable. HUD has confirmed that Petitioners’ primary lender, Bank of America, terminated the FHA insurance on Petitioners’ primary mortgage in error.” The Secretary has confirmed that the FHA insurance on Petitioners’ home was erroneously terminated and has been reinstated. Accordingly, HUD’s Subordinate Notes are not due and payable at this time, and HUD has ceased all collection actions against Petitioners.

Upon due consideration, and for good cause shown, the *Motion to Dismiss* is **GRANTED**. The stay of referral in this matter to the Treasury Department shall remain full force and effect.

The matter of HUDOHA # 18-VH-0238-AO-067 is hereby **DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE**.
