DISMISSAL PURSUANT TO SETTLEMENT


The Government filed a *Complaint* against Respondents seeking the imposition of a civil penalty and assessment totaling \$77,531.16, jointly and severally, pursuant to the Program Fraud Civil Remedies Act of 1986, 31 U.S.C. §§ 3801-3812, and 24 C.F.R. Part 28.

Thereafter the Government and Respondent Midtown Mortgage, Inc. engaged in settlement discussions that resulted in a settlement agreement resolving all issues in the matter as they relate to Respondent Midtown Mortgage, Inc. As a result, and pursuant to that agreement, the Government requested dismissal of the matter against Respondent Midtown Mortgage, Inc. on May 12, 2015. A copy of the agreement is attached to the *Government's Motion to Dismiss Complaint against Midtown Mortgage Inc. Based on Settlement Agreement* ("Motion"), but the Court has not been asked to review or approve it

Accordingly, for good cause shown, the Government's *Motion* is **GRANTED** and the matter against Respondent Midtown Mortgage, Inc. is **DISMISSED**.

As to Respondent Delaine Williams, the Court's *Notice of Hearing and Order*, dated March 23, 2015, remains in effect.
