ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO DISMISS

On January 4, 2016, the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) filed a *Complaint* against Paula Crowe (Respondent) seeking civil penalties and assessments totaling \$19,104.27 under the Program Fraud Civil Remedies Act of 1986, 31 U.S.C. §§ 3801-3812, as implemented by 24 C.F.R. Part 28. The *Complaint* alleges that Respondent, while Executive Director of the Brackettville Housing Authority (BHA), submitted 43 false or fraudulent claims to the BHA, which receives annual subsidies from HUD.

On March 29, 2016, the Government moved to dismiss the matter as the parties reached a settlement resolving all issues, without admission of liability or fault by any party. The Court has not been asked to review or approve it, but an executed copy of the Settlement Agreement was attached to the *Government's Motion to Dismiss*.

Accordingly, for good cause shown, the above-captioned matter will be DISMISSED.
