Under this program, HUD will execute budget-neutral, performance-based agreements in fiscal years 2016 through 2019 that result in reductions in energy or water costs in affordable multifamily properties assisted through the Section 8 Project-Based Rental Assistance, Section 202, and Section 811 programs.
