\*\*The enrollment target is based on FY 2007 Medicaid child enrollment and adjusted based on a formula that accounts for population growth and for increases in enrollment during an economic recession. States that exceed their enrollment target have increased enrollment above what would have been expected without expanded outreach efforts. States that exceed their enrollment target by more than 10% qualify for a "Tier 2" performance bonus payment, in which additional enrollment is rewarded at a higher rate.

Note: This enrollment data and the related bonus amounts are considered preliminary and subject to reconciliation after States' Medicaid enrollment numbers are finalized in early 2014.
