You must tell us of any changes to the group's registration details, the trading premises or any other details specified in paragraph 10 of Excise Notice 2002, including if any group member stops undertaking a controlled activity, in this case the wholesale of alcohol. If you wish to make any changes to your registration details then these must be made using the AWRS

service, which can be accessed via the AWRS guidance pages on GOV.UK. You must use the same username and password that you used at the time of your original application.

If you fail to notify HMRC of any changes to the group registration details, you may be liable to financial penalties and your alcohol stock will be subject to forfeiture (whether or not duty has been paid). The same penalties could also apply if any of the group members fail to comply with the general conditions and restrictions of the AWRS. Group members are jointly and severally liable for any AWRS penalties. Serious or persistent breaches could result in revocation of the group's approval.

As part of the introduction of the AWRS we are introducing an online look-up service from April 2017 on the GOV.UK website to allow your customers to verify your approval status. Now you have been approved the details of each group member will appear on this service. You must provide your URN to customers if they ask for it.

You will be able to view the final decision in the AWRS service on GOV.UK.
