Dear Colleague,

As you probably know it was decided at the last Gargamelle Users Committee that the next Meeting would be totally devoted to experiments to be performed at CERN with Gargamelle. The Organizing Committee, appointed on that occasion, (Professors Burhop, Lagarrigue, Ramm and myself) decided that a first meeting will take place at the:

- 3) Decays of kaons: J. Lemonne (CERN-NPA), K. Schultze (Aachen).
- Muon physics: M. Baldo Ceolin (Padova), W.F. Fry (Wisconsin).

- . 5) Antiproton physics : R. Salmeron (Ecole Polytechnique Paris)
 - 6) Formation experiments with kaons: G. London and A. Rousset
 (Ecole Polytechnique Paris)
 - 7) Production experiments with kaons: R. Stannard (University College London)
 - 8) Production experiments with pions: J.J. Veillet (Orsay)

I would suggest to the various groups to appoint one, or at the most two representatives for each of the experiments they are interested in, and to contact the coordinators (when there is more than one coordinator, please contact, for the sake of simplicity, the coordinator whose name is underlined). I think the representatives for the various topics should meet at least once before the October meeting.

This letter is an invitation to the Milano Meeting in October; this invitation is of course not only for Heavy Liquid Bubble Chamber experts, but also for people working with hydrogen bubble chambers and with counters and for the theorists. Please extend the invitation to whomever you think could be interested.
