Dear Professor Lehmann,

Answering your letter from Febr.20, 1973, I would like to inform you of our intention in participation in SPS programme. I understood that your demand of letter on intention is not limited only to CERN Member States, therefore, I hope my letter will not embarrass you. High Energy Group of our Institute is rather small with theoretical and experimental activities. In experimental part we have 9 physicists participating partially in Dubna electronic group and partially working on bubble chamber pictures from CERN and Serpuchov. We share, however, the experimental activities with High Energy Group at the Charles University. We hope, our experimental activity in next years will increase to the level of average European group. We would be glad to have the possibility of evaluation of film from BEFS. As our interest is mainly in p interactions /5.7 GeV in collaboration with CERN, 23 GeV with JINR/ we would be glad to participate in some p -programmes: e.g. in interactions in 70-100 GeV of antiprotons in BEFS and perhaps some individual participation in electronic groups. If you found our participation in SPS acceptable, we would be glad to send a formal proposal for experiment.

Regarding to your letter I would be glad if about 3 - 4 physicists would be in future involved in SPS programme. The physicist with whom you may be in contact for further information is V.Šimák and me.

I wish to CERN and to SPS programme great success with hope that our Institute will be able to participate in it.
