Anthony is a Senior Lecturer and Director of the Masters of Advanced Architecture at the University of Technology, Sydney and Director of the design practice Offshore Studio. He specializes in issues on contemporary architectural design and theory related to computation and its implications for the built environment. Anthony has taught and has lectured extensively in Australia and throughout North America, as well as the Royal Australian Institute of Architects national convention and numerous local talks. In 2007 he co-edited "Network practices: New strategies in architecture and design" by Princeton Architectural press, and from 2007-2009 Anthony was invited to join the OCEAN research network. In 2008, Offshorestudio was selected as one of 5 national practices to be exhibited at the Architecture Biennale Beijing in the (im)material Processes exhibition curated by Neal Leach.
