The orders came from every section of the United States, customers resorting to "air mail" and "special delivery service " to speed up their requests. We did not substitute on a single order, except on orders where substitutions were requested, and we promptly refunded the money remitted for all varieties we could not supply. We would rather have kept the money, for we know the person placing the order in each case wanted the Peonies, and then, too, we're human, and like to fill every order completely, but on our "Planting Specials " it is impossible to do it in every case. **FIRST COME - FIRST SERVED**, and we believe it is wise to make a second choice. **WE WILL NOT SUBSTITUTE ON ANY ORDER UNLESS INSTRUCTED TO DO SO, AND WE WILL PROMPTLY REFUND ANY MONEY RECEIVED FOR VARIETIES WE CANNOT SUPPLY.**
