CJI's Programs & Services

- Conflict resolution services (MEDIATION)
- Services for older adults (ELDER MEDIATION)
- Victim Offender Reconciliation Program for Youth & Adults (VORP)
- Support for people impacted by sexual trauma (REVIVE)
- Guided conversations to heal broken relationships among individuals, families & community groups impacted by sexual trauma (FACILITATED DIALOGUE)
- Assistance for families involved with child protection (FAMILY CENTRED SERVICES)
- Support for women while in prison and as they return to the community (STRIDE)
- Support for youth while in custody and as they return to the community (BACKHOME)

Most services are free or available on sliding fee scale.

Community Education

CJI presenters can equip community members to handle conflict and relate restoratively.

We offer:

- Free talks for community groups
- Restorative justice & restorative practice workshops (fee for service)
- Workplace conflict resolution and mediation training (fee for service)

Volunteer with CJI

CJI offers meaningful ways for community members to create opportunities for healing and resolution in situations of crime, conflict, and abuse.

Rather than over-professionalizing our services, CJI staff equip and support well-trained volunteers to carry out our frontline work.
