

Delegations are encouraged to limit their statements for the general debate to a maximum of eight minutes. Statements on behalf of a group of countries should not exceed 12 minutes. The list will give priority to high-level representatives and should be shared with the Committee on a regular basis so as to increase transparency. Wide civil society participation is encouraged.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>b</sup> During thematic discussions, delegations are encouraged to limit their statements to a maximum of five minutes; statements on behalf of a group of countries should not exceed seven minutes.
