REGULATION FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF COMMUNITY BOARDS UNDER THE SPECIAL COMMUNITIES PROGRAM

The Office for Socioeconomic and Community Development of Puerto Rico (ODSEC) in accordance with Section 2.1 of Law No. 38 of 2017 as amended, known as the "Uniform Administrative Procedure Law of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico", has published the draft of regulation mentioned above.

The proposed regulation has the purpose of facilitating compliance with the legal provisions of Law No. 10-2017, as amended, known as the "Organic Law of the Office for Socioeconomic and Community Development of Puerto Rico". Which establishes the obligation to adopt the necessary regulations for the effective implementation of the duties and responsibilities of the ODSEC. It seeks to adopt the corresponding Regulation to support and facilitate the creation of the Community Boards attached to the Special Communities Program.

The text of the proposed Regulation will be available from Monday to Friday during working hours from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm at the reception of the ODSEC headquarters located at 1208 Roosevelt Avenue, San Juan, PR 00920.
