

European - United States Defence Expenditure in 2008

Brussels, December 2009

The EDA has compared its data on European defence expenditure with United States defence spending in 2008. The data show that the US spent €454 Billion on defence in 2008, two point two times more than the €200 billion spent in Europe.

European data represent spending by the 26 EDA participating Member States. US data are based on public sources, mainly US Government publications.

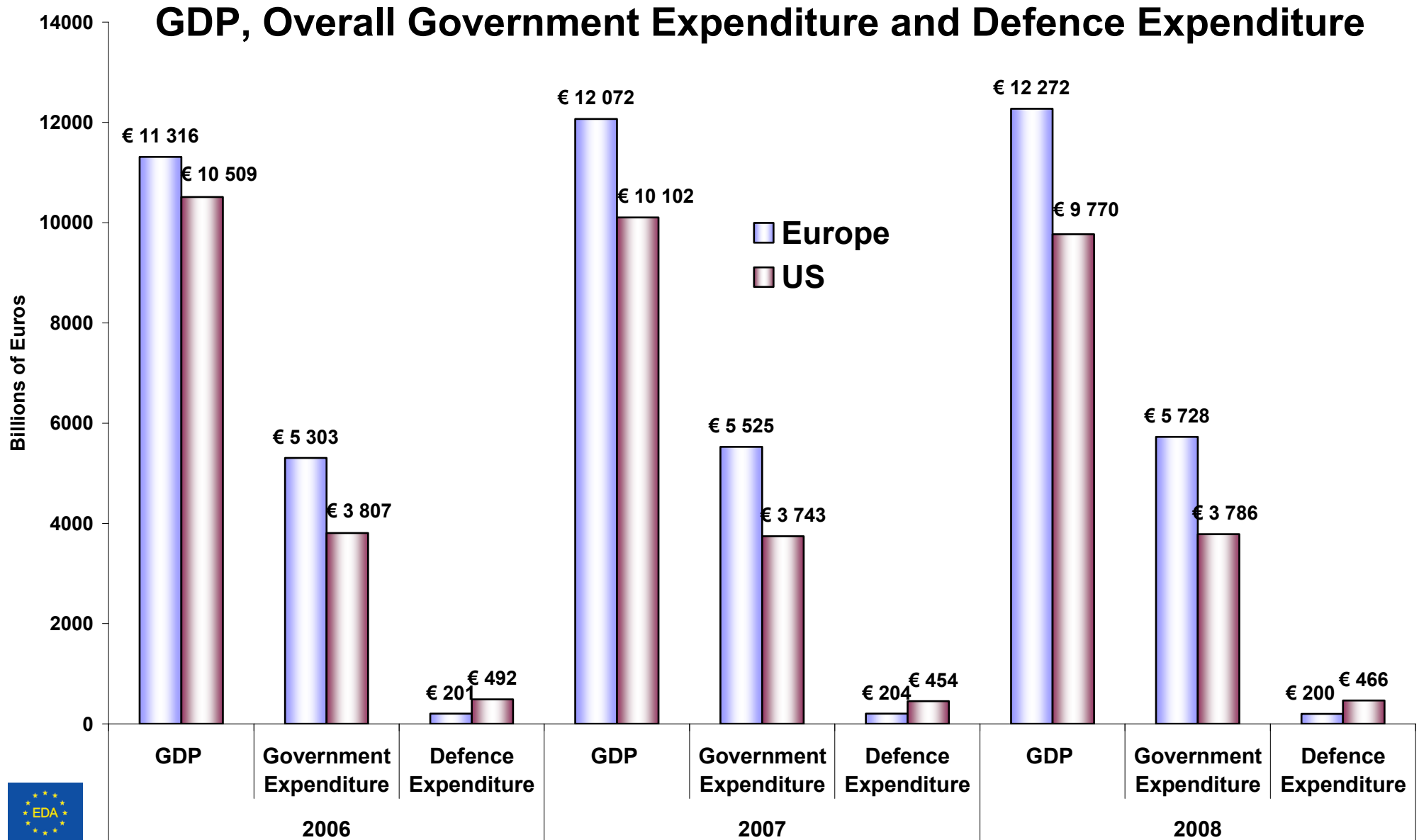

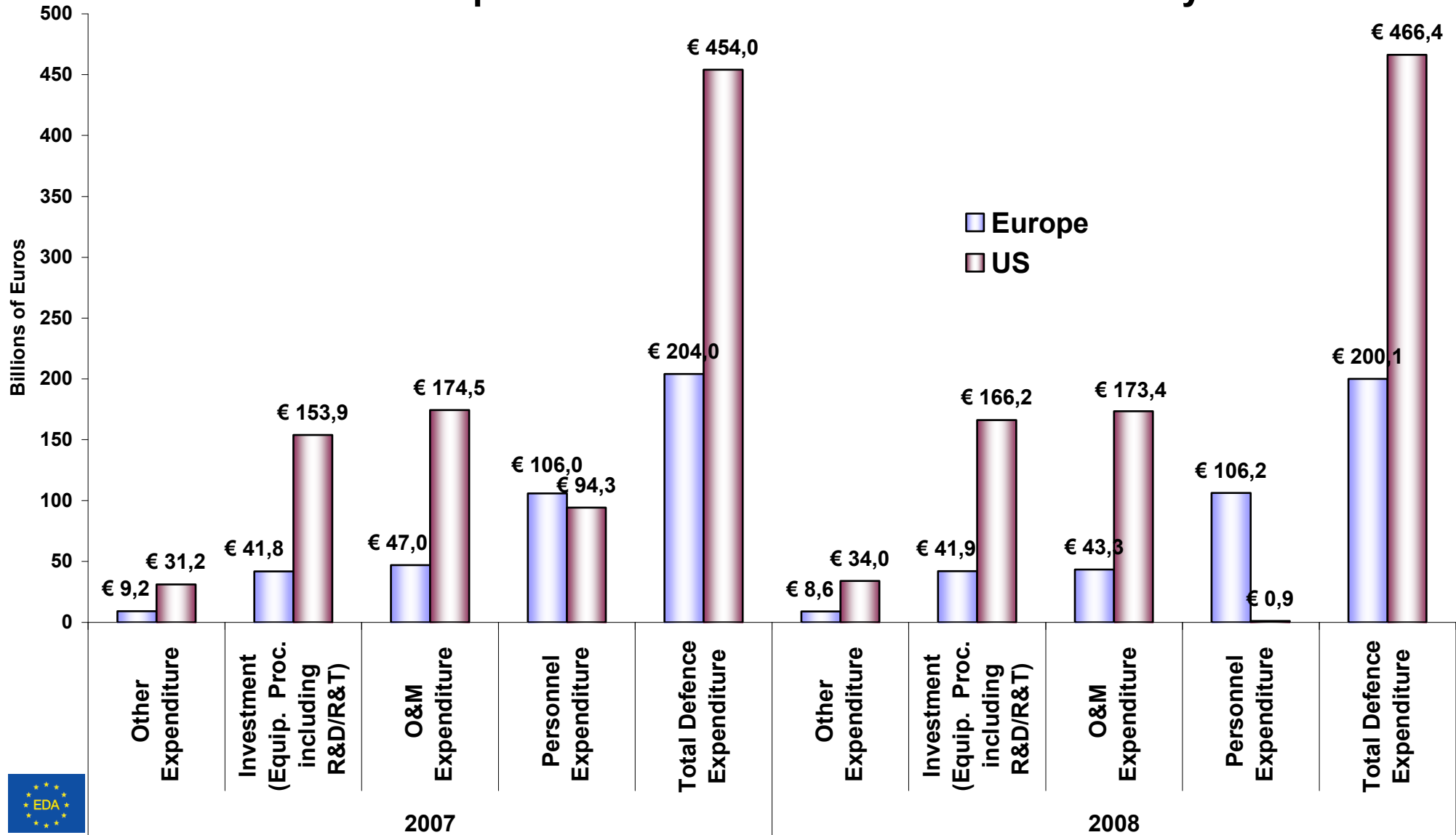

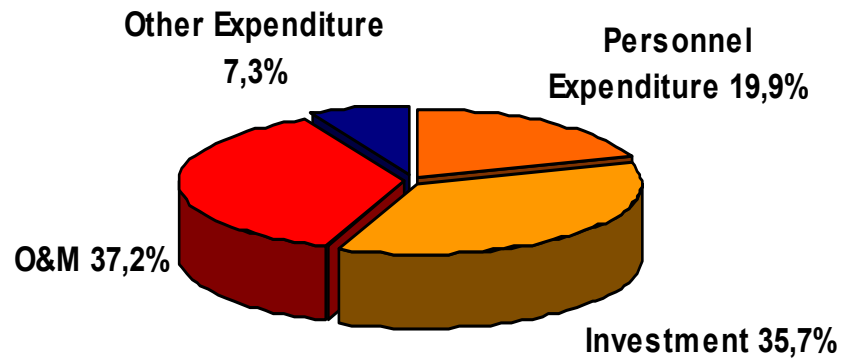
Defence Expenditure Breakdown in Volume of Money



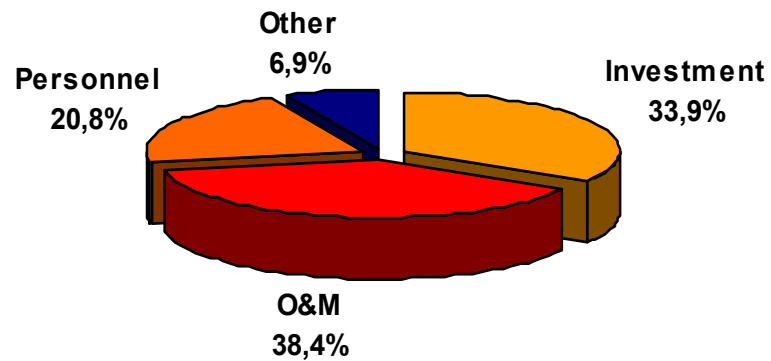

Defence Expenditure Breakdown in Percentages

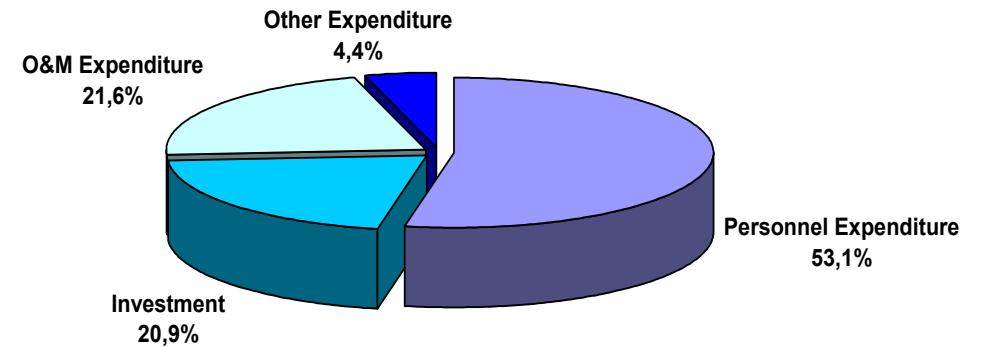

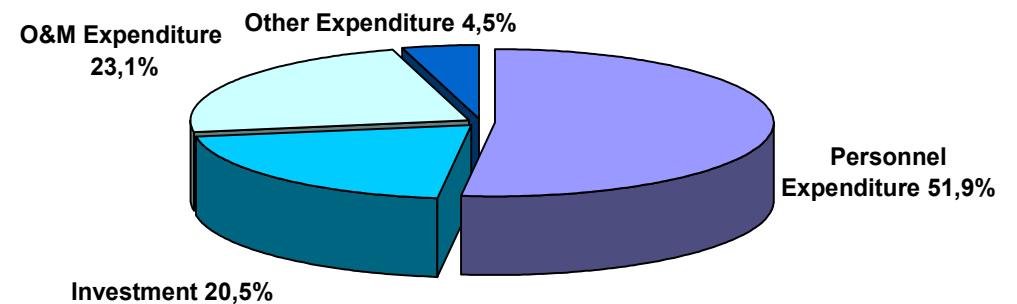

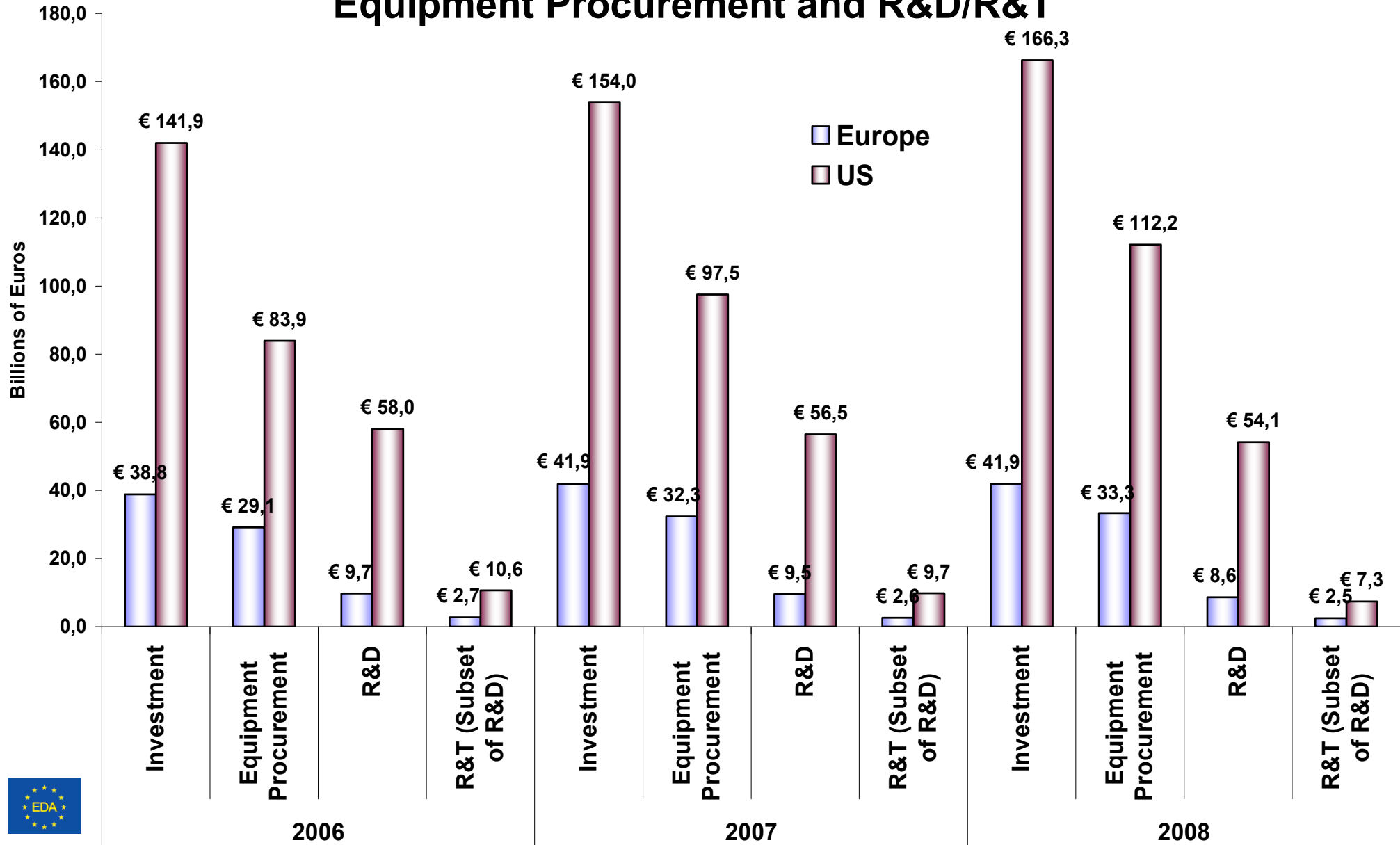

Equipment Procurement and R&D/R&T

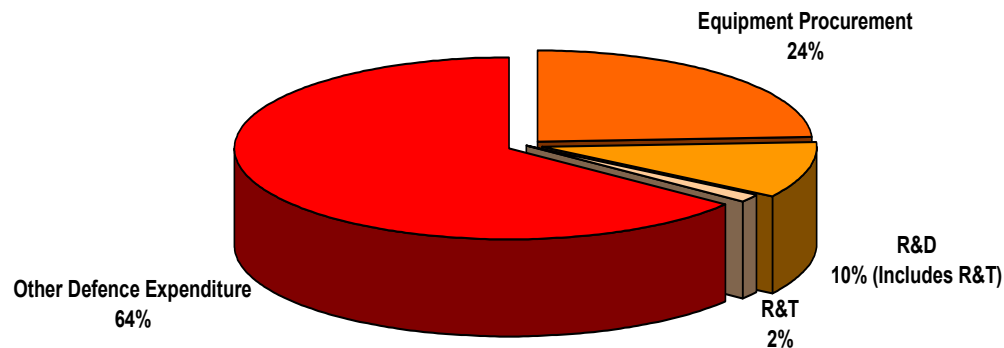

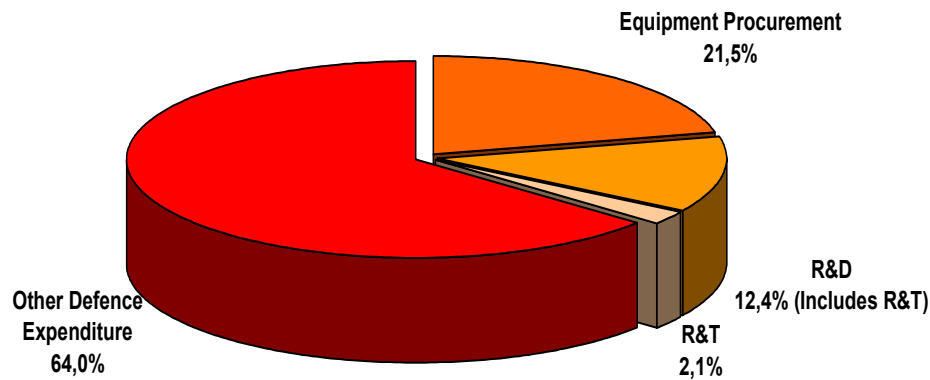
Equipment Procurement and R&D/R&T in Percentages

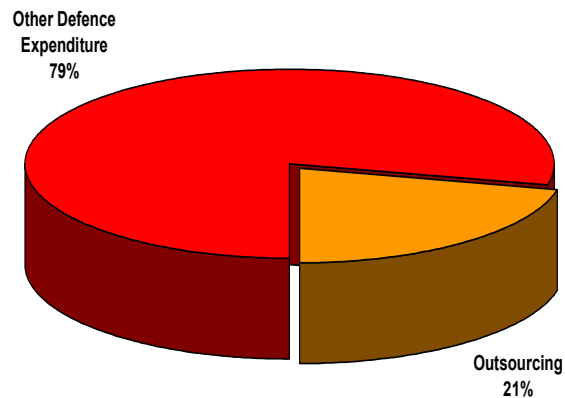

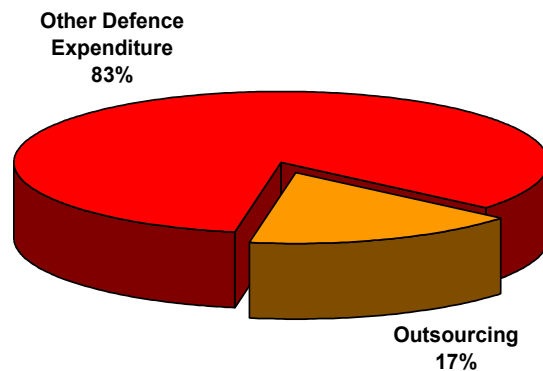
Outsourcing in Volume of Money and Percentages

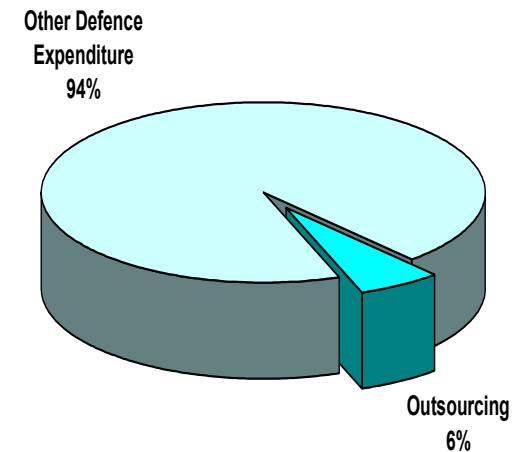


2007 Outsourcing: €76,2 bln

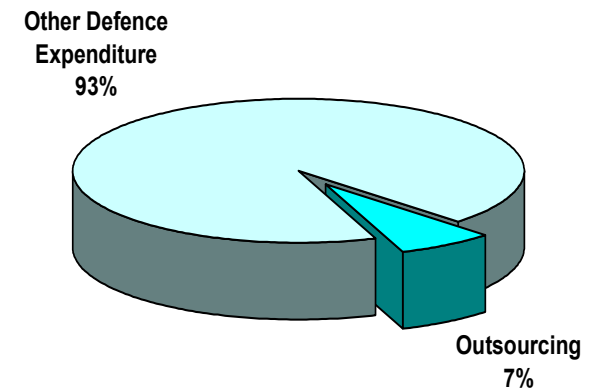

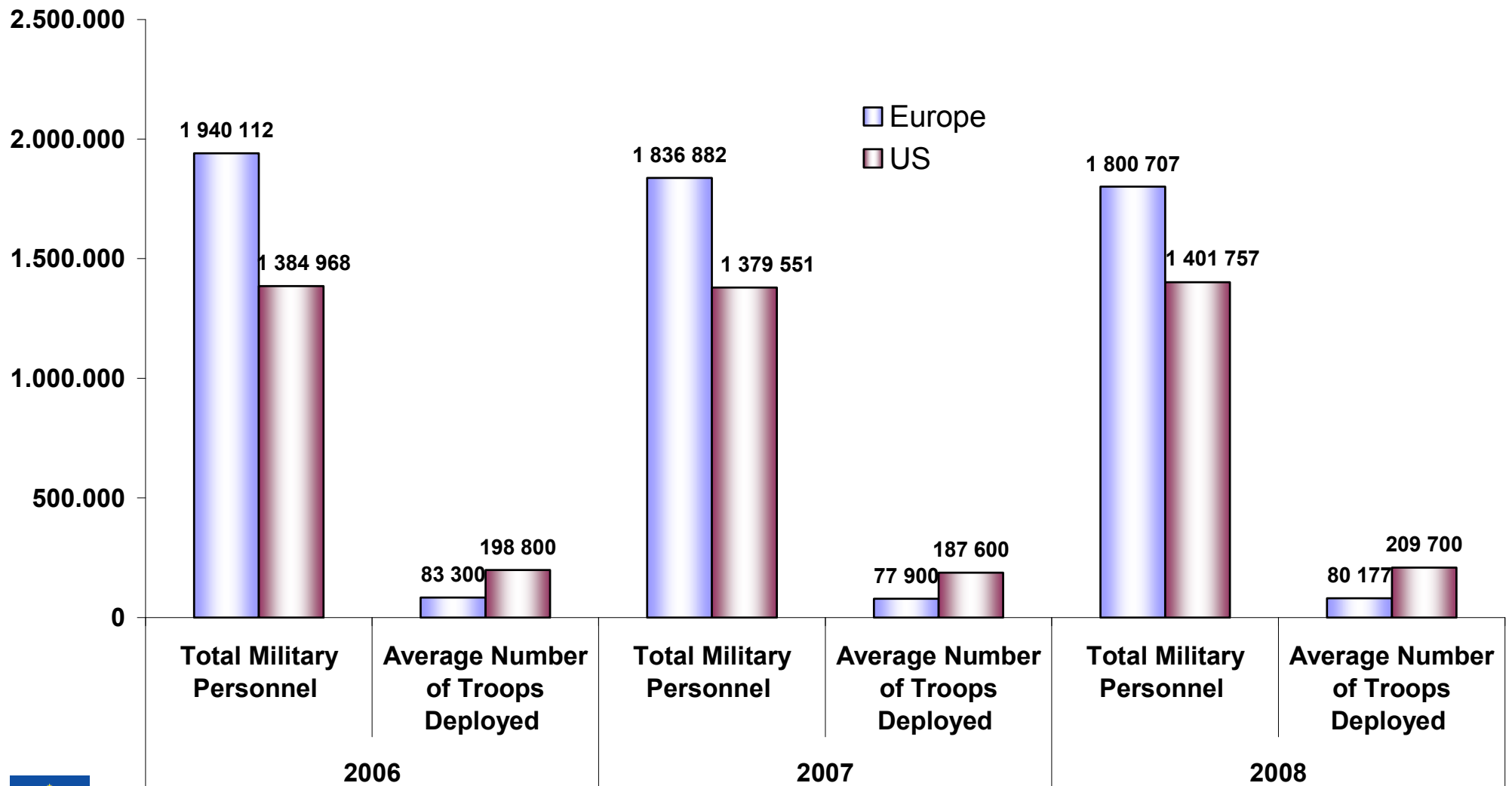

Average Number of Troops Deployed in Figures



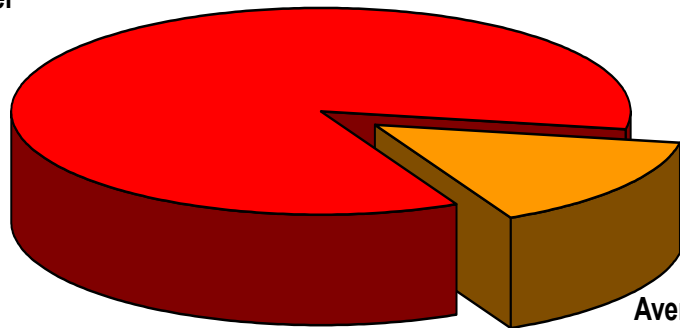

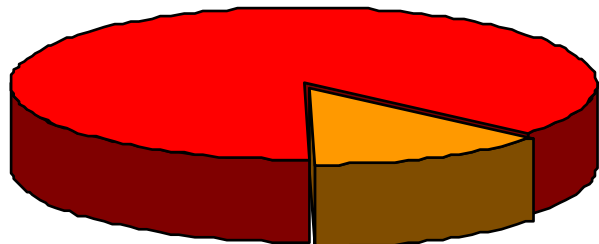

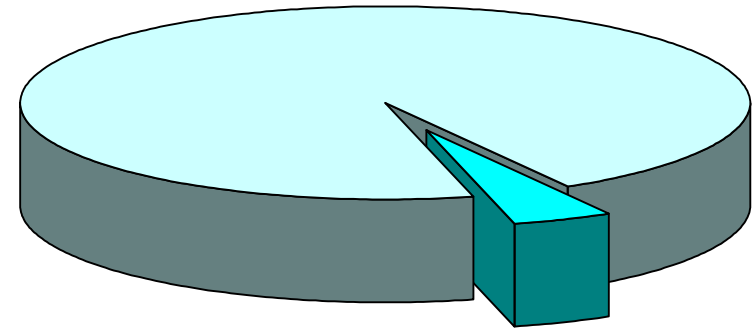

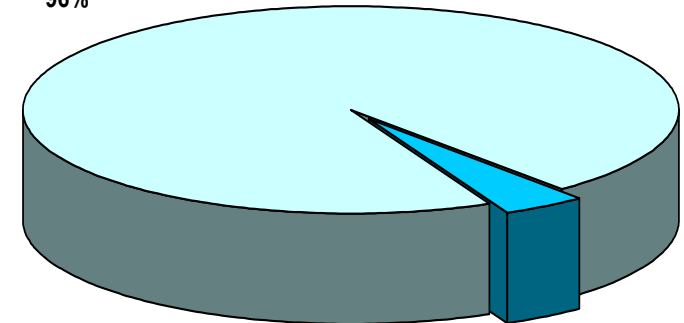
